Comparing data changes from 20-21 to 21-22
 - All ELA and Math scores show improvement and increased scores in all areas. Science Level 3+ scores were impacted by covid and was heavy on 4th grade standards that some students missed out on.
 - Audubon ELA/ Math/ and science data shows that Audubon outperformed the district averages in all areas.
 - Audubon's school grade improved in 21-22 by increasing the percentage of 61% to earn a B school rating. (62% and above is an A)
 - Audubon no longer has any ESSA subgroups (Black/ African/ Disabilities/ English Language Learners scoring below 41%)
