Youth Truth Survey Data/ Campus Updates

Audubon Elementary Staff Survey showed an overall positive outlook with highest themes including professional development and support and student engagement. The lowest themes were school safety and relationships. The Family Survey (34 surveyed out of 332 surveys were completed) indicated high themes of school safety and communication & feedback with the lowest themes of relationships and engagement. The student survey (42 students) showed high themes in engagement and belonging with the lowest themes of instructional methods and academic challenge.

Book Review

Media Specialist (Kirkland) provided copies of future book titles for library/ classroom use. All SSYRA titles were reviewed and approved by the school advisory committee.
