How?

Graduate from high school with a standard diploma.

Complete 3 high school credits in an approved sequential Career and Technical Education (CTE) program of study.

Complete 30 hours of community service as approved by the district.

Achieve a 3.5 unweighted GPA in a minimum of 3 credits in one CTE program.

Earn a weighted GPA of at least 3.0 in the 16 core credits.

Achieve a minimum score on the PERT or an equivalent score on the ACT or SAT.

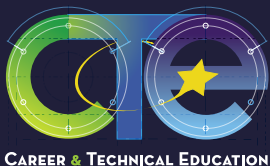
Gold Seal rewards **YOU** for your academic and technical achievement, by funding your pursuit of career goals and higher education.
