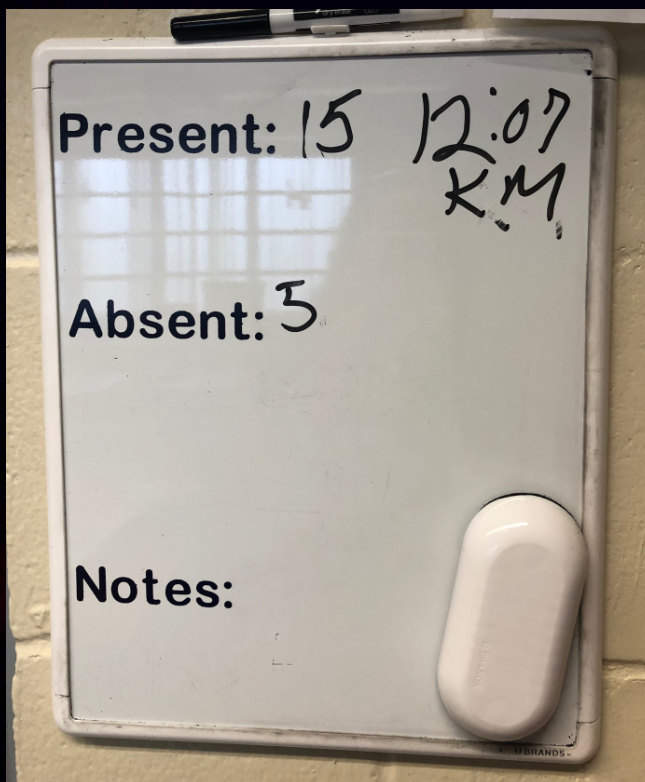

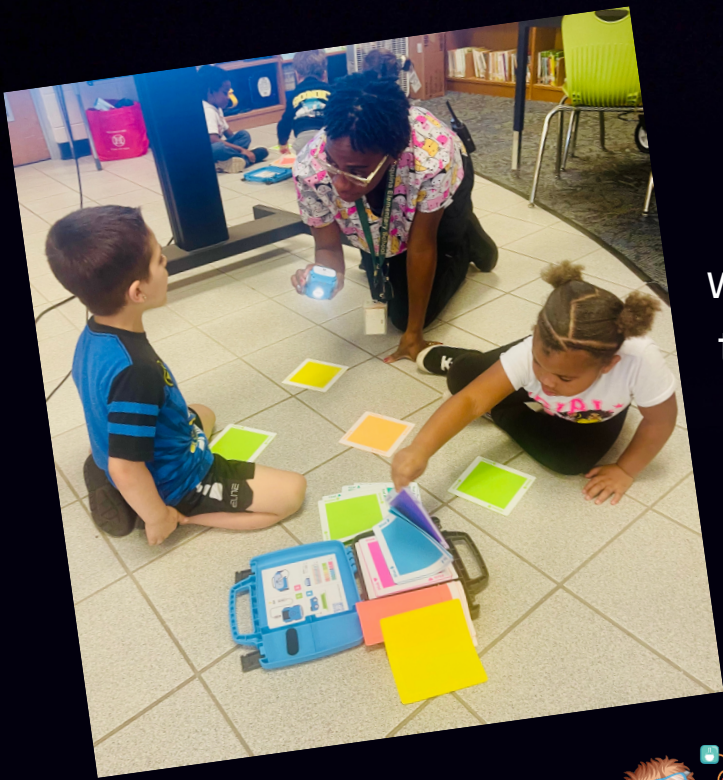


Thank you to all the staff keeping their board updated and correct. This is an **IMPORTANT** Active Supervision strategy for every classroom.

Scan and Count

Staff are always able to account for the children in their care. They continually scan the entire environment to know where everyone is and what they are doing. They count the children frequently. This is especially important during transitions, when children are moving from one location to another.





Mrs. Fuller's class participated in a coding and robotics lesson using Sphero Indi technology, an entry-level learning robot. The students worked together to design and build their own mazes to learn the basics of coding and computational thinking skills through hands-on, interactive play.

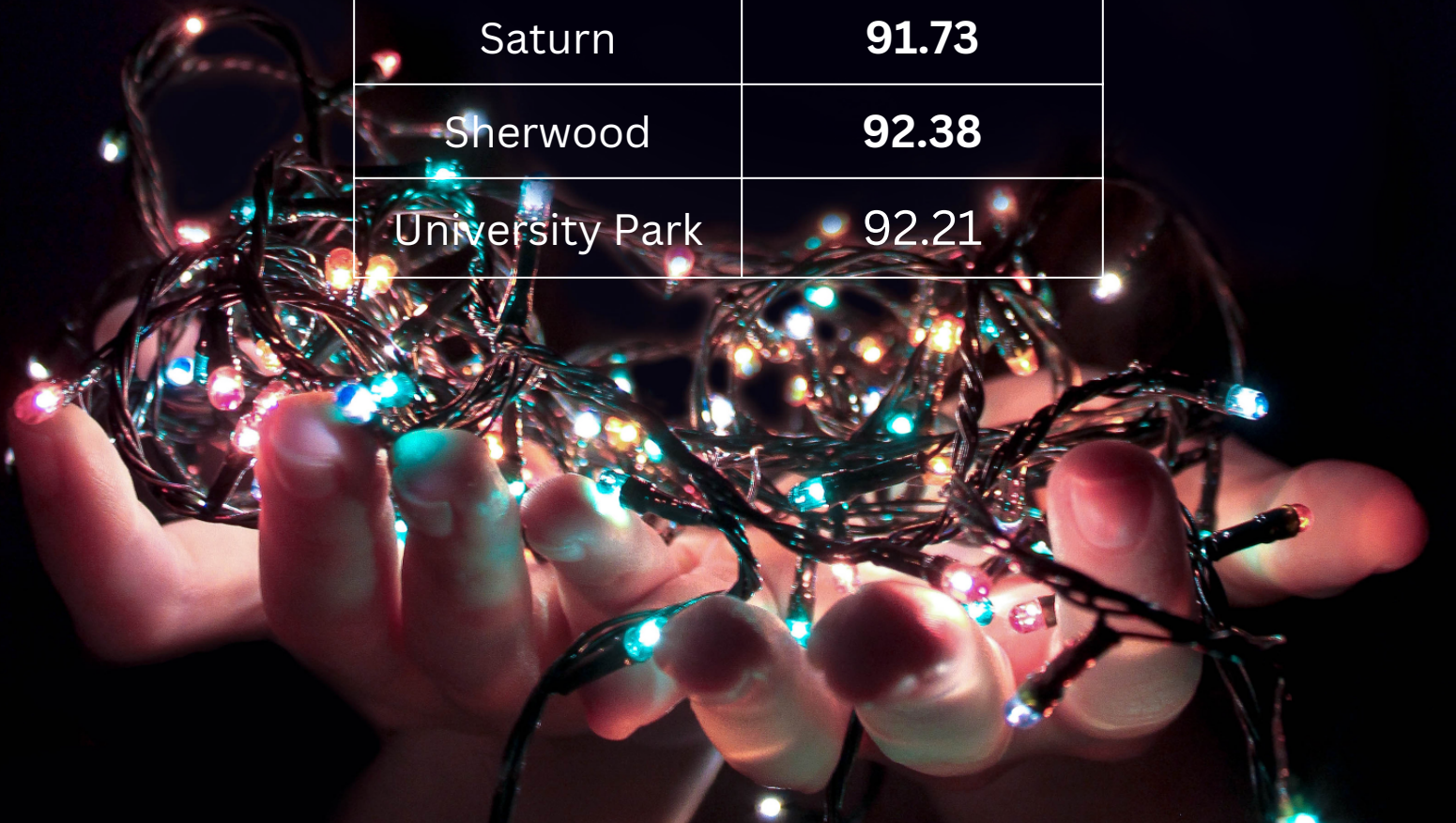

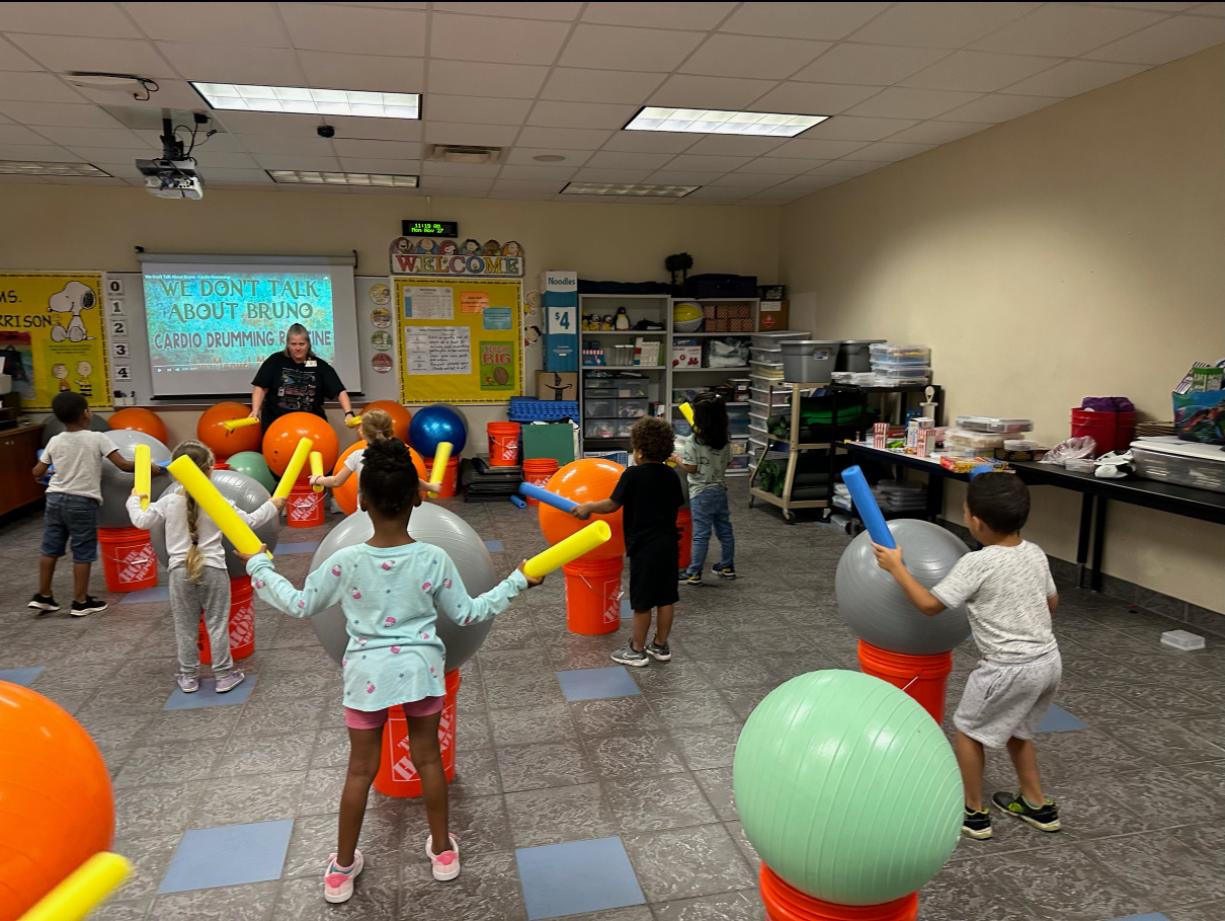

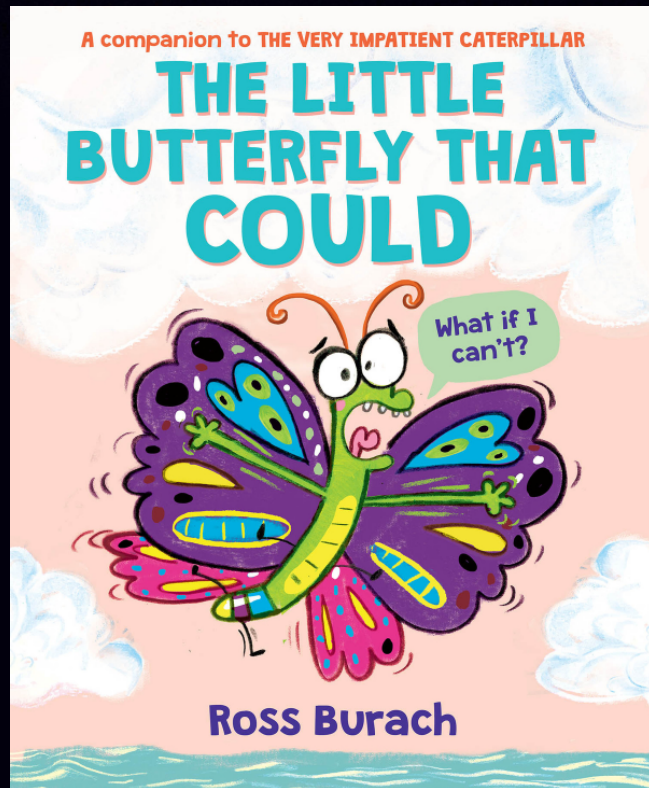
