# Freshman Applicants APPLY TO USF IN 4 EASY STEPS

### **1** Submit Application

Complete the USF online application or complete the one your started in **Coalition** or **Common App**.

#### 2 Pay Application Fee

Pay the non-refundable \$30 application fee (if you have not done so already) or submit an ACT/SAT application fee waiver to **admissions@usf.edu**. If the application fee was not paid at the time of application submission, you may pay it online via **OASIS**.

#### **3** Send Official Transcripts

High School Students: Ask your school to send transcripts to USF electronically.
 If this option is not available, official transcripts should be mailed to:

- GED Students: Request an official transcript through GED Testing Services.
- Home-School Students: Complete our Home-School Transcript Template if an official transcript is not available.

## **4** Send Official SAT or ACT Scores

Request official SAT scores directly from The College Board. USF code is 5828.

Request official ACT scores directly from ACT, Inc. USF code is 0761.

Students are only **required** to submit either SAT or ACT scores, but they are **encouraged** to submit both. USF superscores, meaning we consider your highest submitted section scores across all SAT and ACT test dates. Final admission decisions are made using only your highest cumulative scores.
