



Program Requirement Overview

- Runs August through May
- A minimum of 150 internship hours per credit must be worked to meet course requirements
- Multiple credits can be earned based on school schedule availability
- Internships can be paid or un-paid
- Summer and school-year internships are available and are based on industry opportunities
- Internship placements must align with the CTE program of study. An example would be a technical design student placed at an architecture firm.
