



Important Facts before you enroll

- Students are encouraged to enroll in Home Education at the beginning of the semester.
- Assignment grades are not transferable. Only final grades are transferable.
- Home education students DO NOT earn a high school diploma. ([S.1002.41, F.S.](#))
- Home education students may take courses at the zone school or participate in extracurricular activities. ([S.1006.15, F.S.](#))
- The parent is responsible for maintaining all records.

Current Brevard Students - Enrollment Procedures

1. Withdraw the student from the current school.
2. Complete the Notice of Intent (NOI) to home educate found under the FORMS section of the website.
3. Submit your NOI at your child's [neighborhood school](#) in person for a quicker registration and verification letter turnaround time.
4. Select your curriculum
 - a. Brevard Virtual School (BVS) using FLVS Flex Platform - Additional enrollment is required through [flvs.net](#) or;
 - b. FLVS Flex - Additional enrollment is required through [flvs.net](#) or;
 - c. Other parent-selected virtual or traditional curricula
5. Start instructing your student with your preferred curriculum

Note: NOI's may be mailed or emailed to homeeducation@brevardschools.org, however, processing of this form by the district office is a minimum of 3-5 days after receipt. It may take as long as 10 business days before you receive a verification letter through the U.S. mail or email
