This request includes modifications in Brevard Public Schools for the total budget program including Roll Forward and increased allocation adjustment funds from the state.

Requested LEA-Level Changes

BPS needs to correct function and object funding for previously approved activities. We need to move funds from the 5100/120 function and object string into the 6300/180 function and object string. BPS will be decreasing overbudgeted funds for the previously approved CPR certifications activity to fund payments to the Red Cross for training BPS employees to become CPR trainers for our employees. We will also be funding extra duty pay for those employees choosing to become certified and training outside of the workday. BPS will be increasing funds for the purchase of Advanced Placement materials for our schools.



BPS is requesting a reallocation of funds, including the Title IV, Part A allocation adjustment, to increase support for previously approved STEM initiatives. The reallocation will be used to purchase additional STEM kits for K-12 STEM programs.

- To support the increased need for STEM supplies in our K-12 programs we are reallocating surplus funds from the following previously approved activities:
 - 1. Funds originally allocated to fund textbooks for Pirates to Panthers dual enrollment.
 - 2. Funds originally allocated to fund dues and fees for Pirates to Panthers dual enrollment.
 - 3. Funds originally allocated to fund Instructional Assistant salaries.
 - 4. Funds originally allocated to fund Support Staff salaries.

BPS Roll Forward Allocation

Conscious Discipline Training

- A. Description of the program: In June of 2023, 22 BPS School sites will be sending teams to a Conscious Discipline Academy in Brevard County. The Academy will deepen the organization's implementation of Conscious Discipline, with a focus on building and strengthening the School Family. Creating a strong School Family optimizes the learning environment by developing Safety, Connection, and Problem-Solving powers and skills in adults and the children they work with every day. A team of Instructors and Specialists from Conscious Discipline will help our staff strengthen their sense of community, practice key concepts, problem solve ongoing challenges, and hone implementation of the skills and structures of Conscious Discipline.
- B. Group, grade-level, and number of students impacted by the program activity: K-12 Educators and administrators from 22 BPS schools, serving roughly 13,000 students.
