

School Board of Brevard County VOLUNTEER QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES

Disqualification from Eligibility -

A person is ineligible to volunteer in a Brevard Public School, if the person has been convicted of <u>ANY</u> felony offense prohibited under any of the following statutes:

Convicted is defined as a judicial finding of guilt, a plea of guilty, a plea of nolo contender or entering into a pre-trial intervention program, whether or not there is a formal adjudication of guilt or if the case has been dissolved or expunged.

PENDING CHARGES

Candidates with pending charges will be placed in a suspended status until the criminal case has been judicially closed. Candidates with pending misdemeanor traffic offenses may be reviewed at the discretion of the District based upon the nature of the charge.

PROBATION

Candidates currently on probation will not be cleared until all sanctions are complete and documentation from the courts stating probation has ended.
