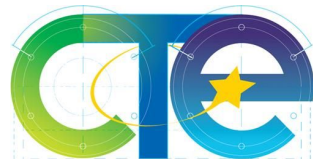

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Here are just some of the skills students will possess after successfully completing the program:

- Programs located at Merritt Island, Palm Bay, Satellite and Viera High Schools.
- Comprehension of competencies from the DCF 40-hour Introductory Childcare. Training coursework
- Program has dual enrollment option. Students can earn college credit certificate from Eastern Florida State College.
- Discuss methods to promote positive attitudes and skills for daily routines for children.
- Describe the characteristic of children ages birth to eight in the following domains: physical development; approaches to learning; social and emotional; language and communication; and cognitive development and general knowledge.

- Observes, records, and reports the behavior of children using various observation tools.
- Defines and models the concept of active and developmentally appropriate learning.
