CONTENT AREA SPECIALIST REPORT: JULY 2021

EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT, TEACHING AND LEARNING

Daily instruction in the Summer Intervention Program during the month of June provided opportunities for developing independence and self-confidence through self-selected activities and building and maintaining relationships with adults and peers, activities to model and reinforce daily routines (e.g., classroom, lunchroom and playground), the use of read alouds with books about going to kindergarten, explicit and systematic instruction in phonological awareness, phonics, language and vocabulary development, and listening comprehension, based on individual child need. *(1302.92 Teaching & Learning Environment)*

EARLY CHILDHOOD HEALTH AND WELLNESS

Health services staff planned and prepared for the 2021-22 school year and prepared parent communication to obtain information regarding child medical and dental status. *(1302.42 Child Health Status and Care)*

As children registered for school year a review of physicals and immunizations was completed to begin the process of determining child health status. *(1302.42 Child Health Status and Care)*

PARENT FAMILY AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT (PFCE)

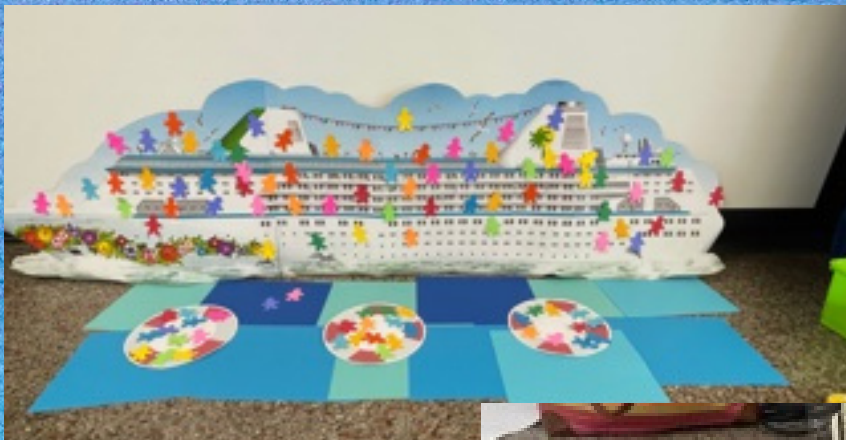
