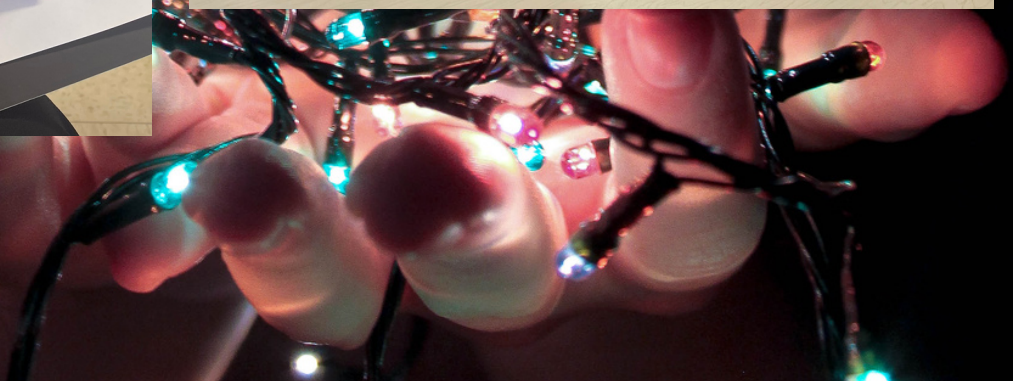
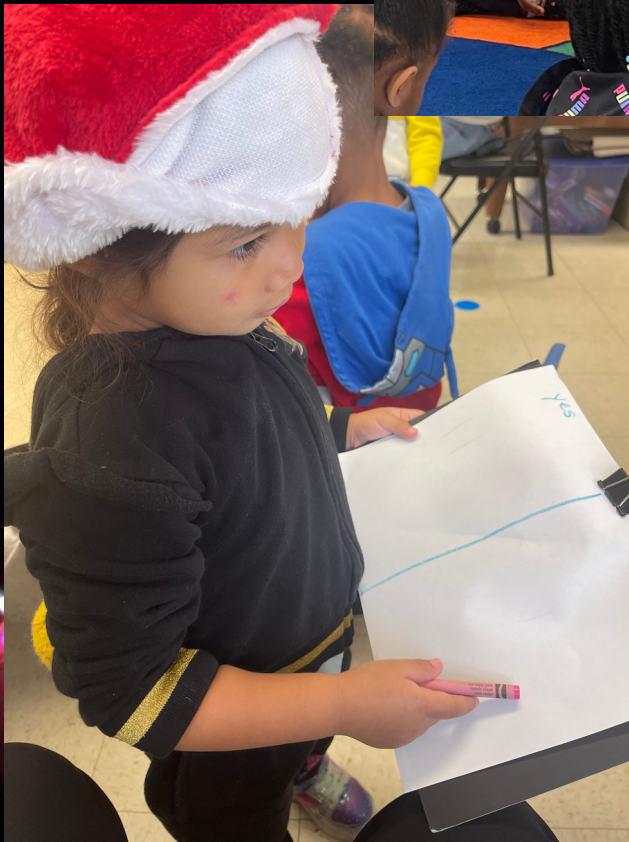


**Knees to knees and nose to nose

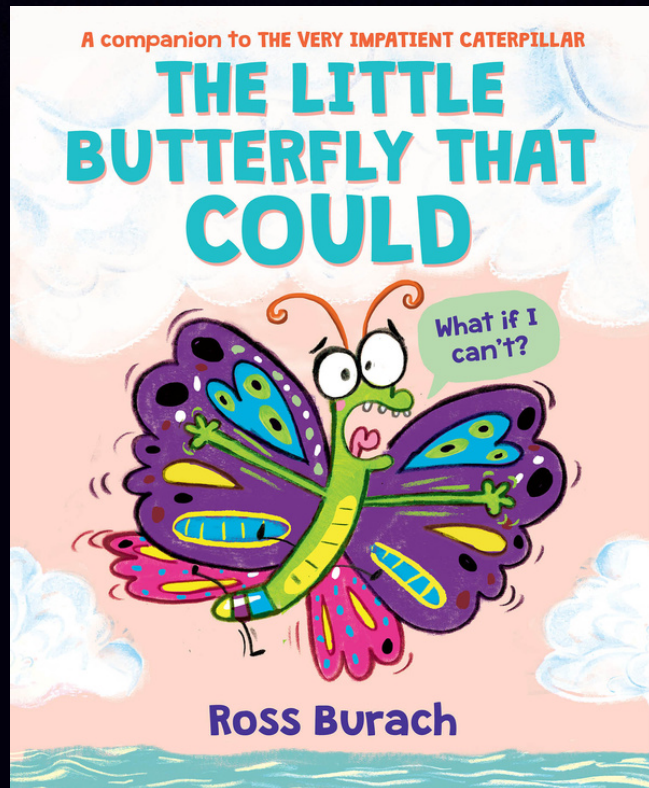
