

## **Career and Technical Education (CTE) Opportunities**

### **Nondegree Full-Time Vocational Instructional Personnel**

Qualifications to teach are established on a combination of educational and occupational expertise in areas of business/finance, healthcare occupations, skilled trades such as construction, manufacturing, and auto mechanics, information technology, and public service education; and who are assigned to teach only vocational courses.

You must hold at least a high school diploma, or the equivalent based on general education development tests or other achievement tests approved by the State Board which establishes the equivalency for high school diploma.

A valid certificate, registration, or license which was issued by a recognized State or national credentialing agency in an area specific to the area of assignment may be required.

Documentation of industry certification when state or national industry certifications are applicable.
