All coolers below 41 df, freezers below 0 df. Food temps: Hamburgers, chicken burgers, taco meat, Teriyaki chicken, rice, cheese sauce, crinkled fries, chicken nuggets temped at 178-199 df. Salad cups, chicken salad, mixed veggie cups, milk temped at 34-38 df. Staff bathroom sanitary w supplies. No visible sign of vermin or sanitary nuisance observed at the time.
