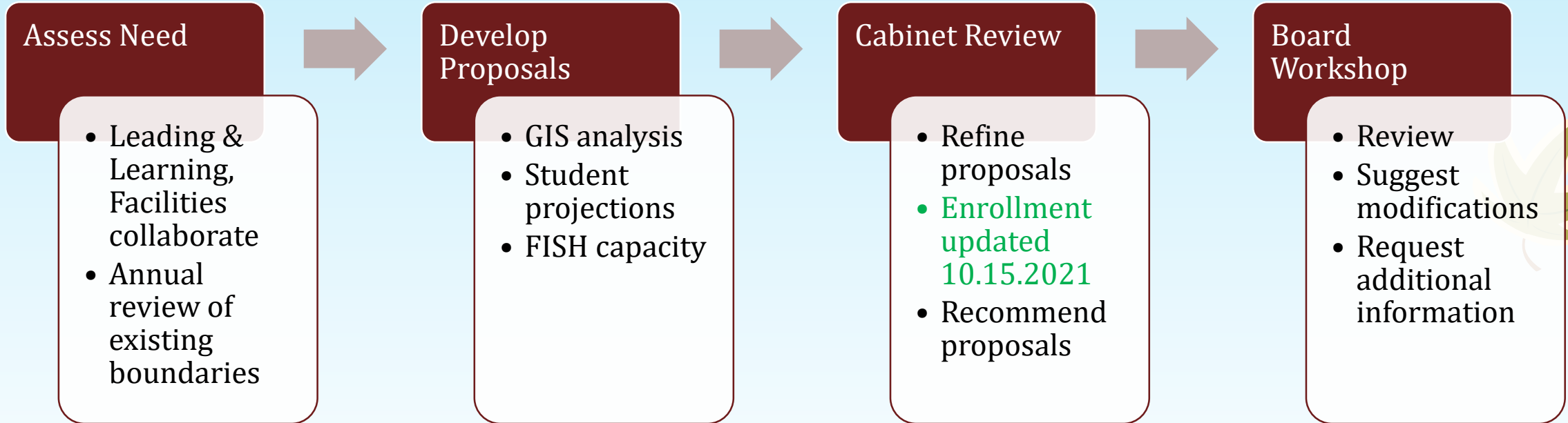

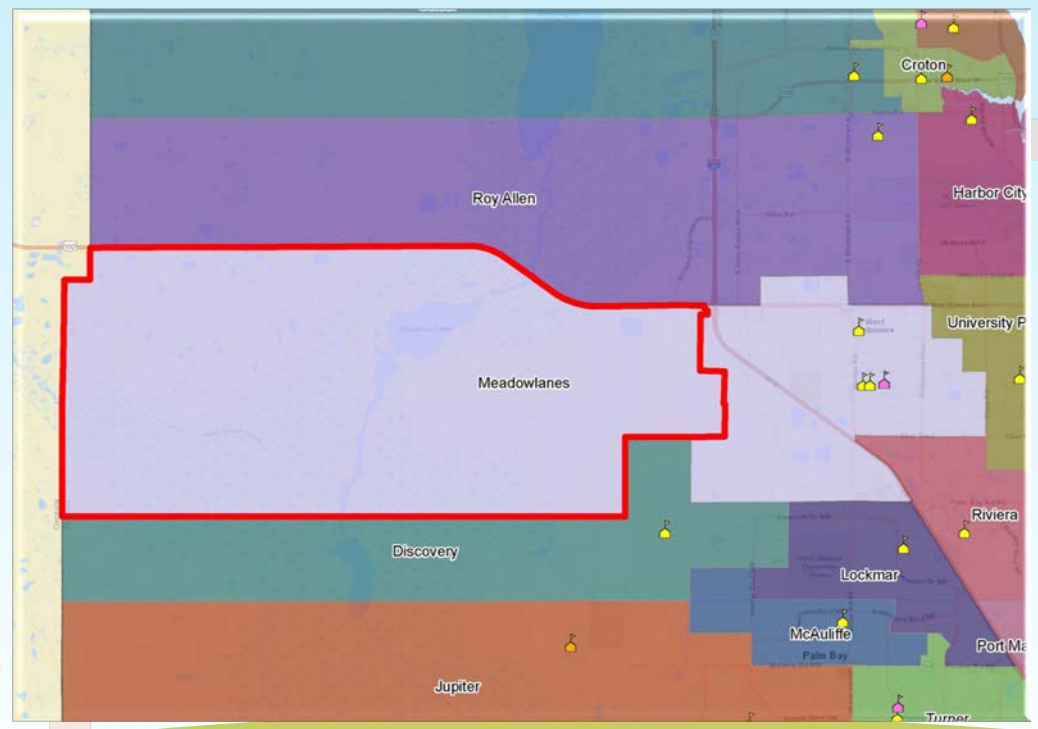

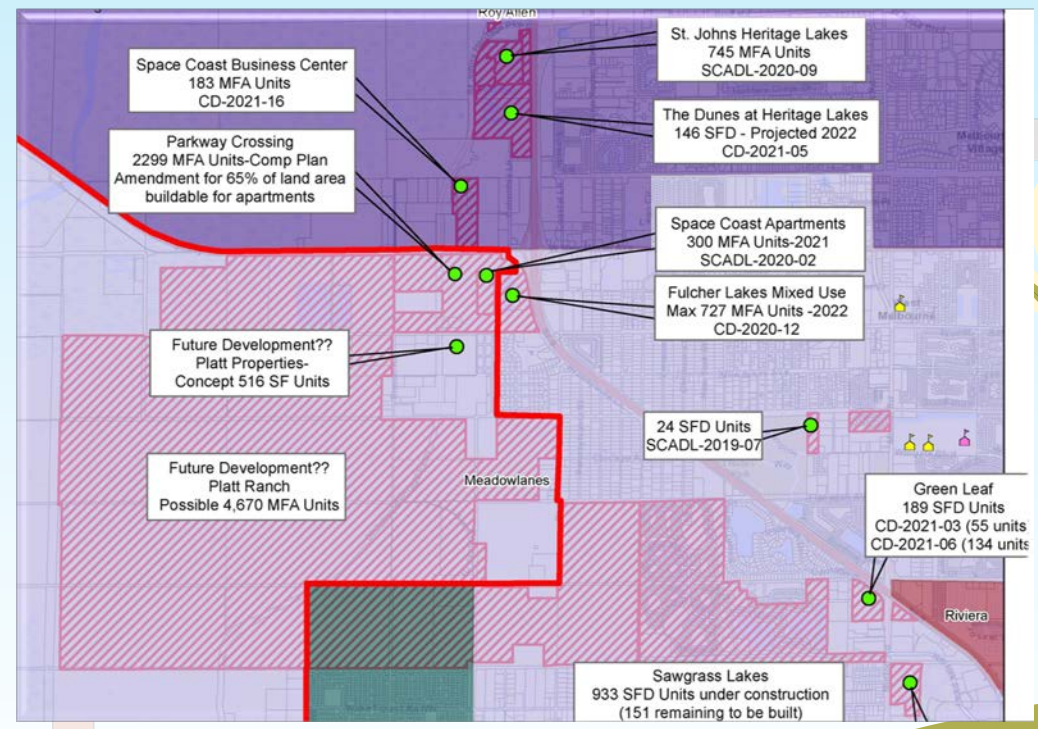

The intent of this proposal is to adjust attendance boundaries ahead of significant growth anticipated in the area south of US 192 and west of Interstate 95.

Anticipated growth in the area south of US 192

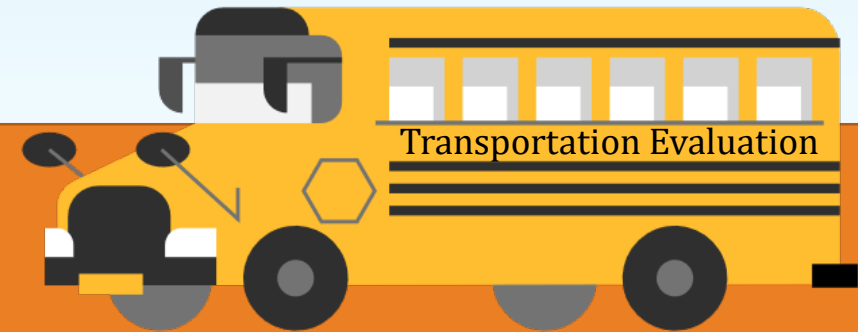
Meadowlanes to Discovery Elementary School

- Proactive shift ahead of expected residential growth.
 - Space Coast Apartments (300 Units, 81 projected elementary students and a potential to build 2000 additional units, adding 540 elementary students in future phases)
 - PMG West Melbourne (preliminary 770 Multi-family units, 208 elementary students)
 - Future development potential of over 4,000 units west along St Johns Heritage Parkway, could generate over 1000 elementary students.

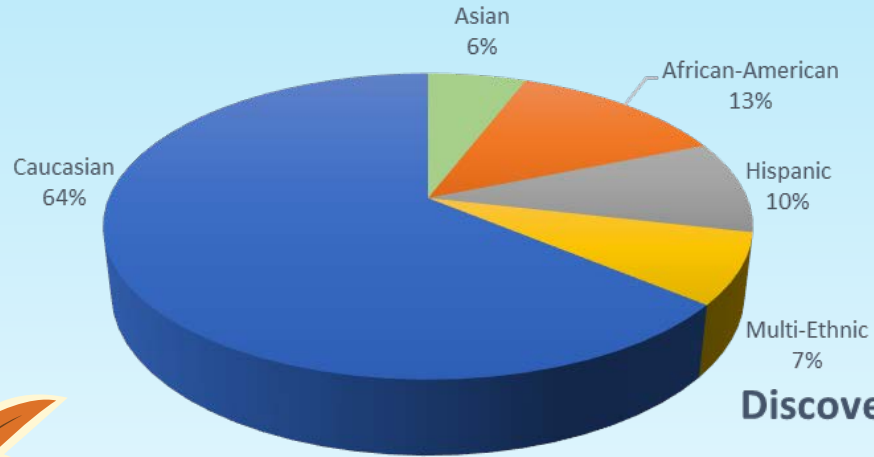

- No effect on students within a 2-mile radius
- All students would be outside the 2-mile boundary and eligible for a bus.
- As new homes are built, buses will be added to Discovery
- The scenario has no effect on bus rides over 45 minutes.

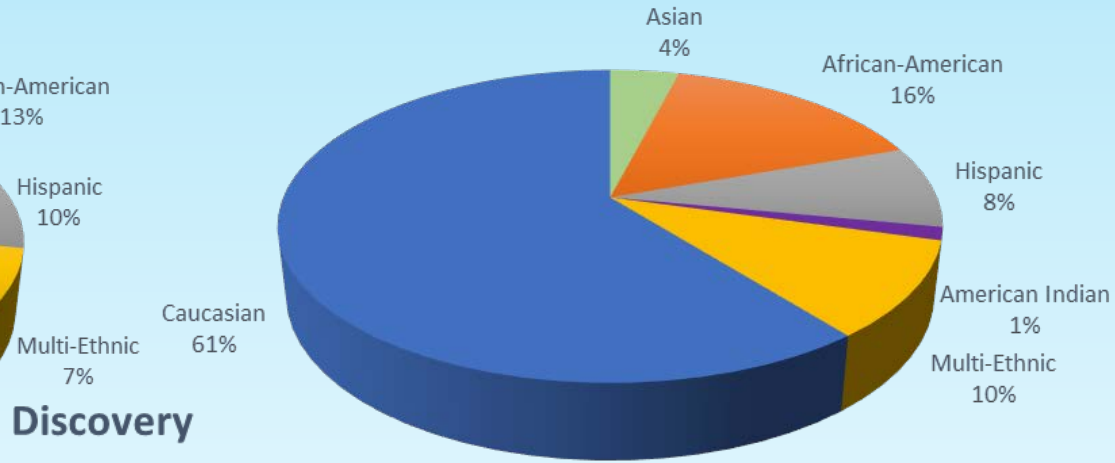

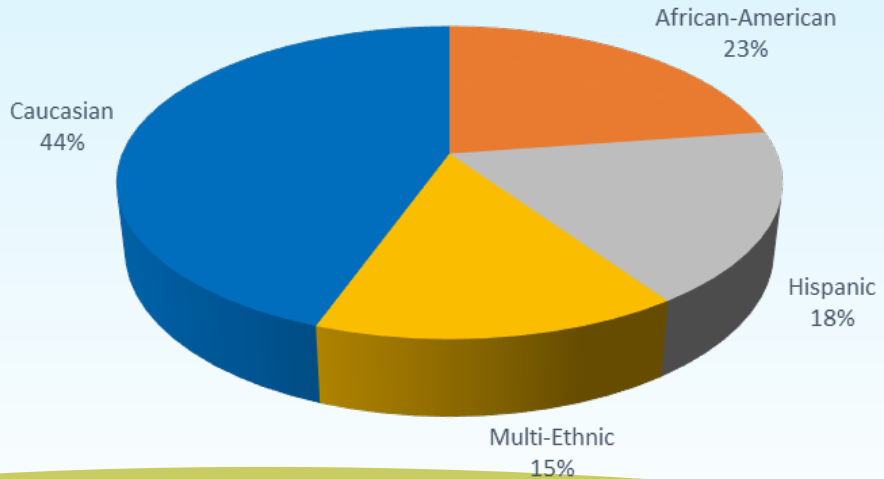

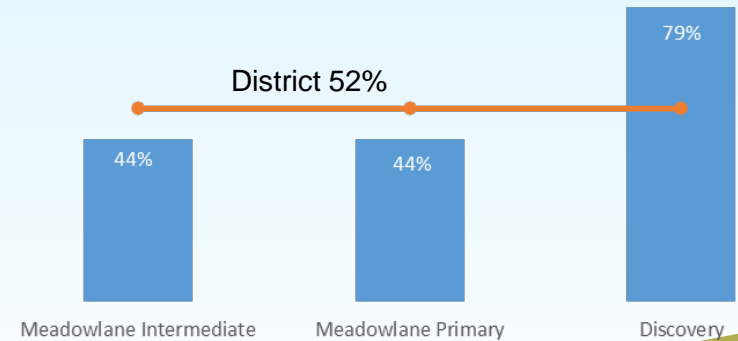

Area south of Cheney Highway and west of Barna Avenue

- SY 2022-2023
 - Remains zoned for Apollo
 - ELO to Imperial Estates (no fee)
 - Communication to parents
 - New students zoned for Apollo but encouraged to ELO to Imperial
- SY 2023-2024
 - Implement rezoning
 - Special Consideration
 - Rising 6th graders
- Modify registration and school zone software to ensure staff/parents are aware of change

Apollo to Imperial Estates Elementary School



- SY22-23
 - Bussing to Apollo only
 - ELO to Imperial (no fee), walk or parent transport
- SY23-24
 - Bussing to Imperial Estates only
 - About ½ can walk
 - Doesn't reduce number of busses – just riders
 - ELO to stay at Apollo (\$30 fee) – no transportation

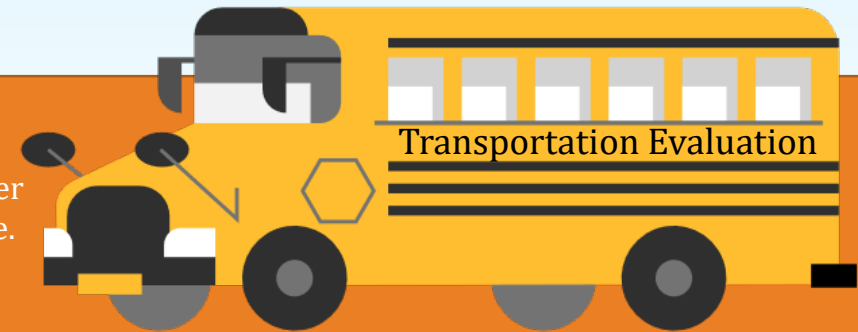
Apollo to Imperial Estates Elementary School

- 52 students affected
- Waive \$30 fee for Apollo families **in the area to be rezoned** that choose to ELO to Imperial Estates in SY 22-23.

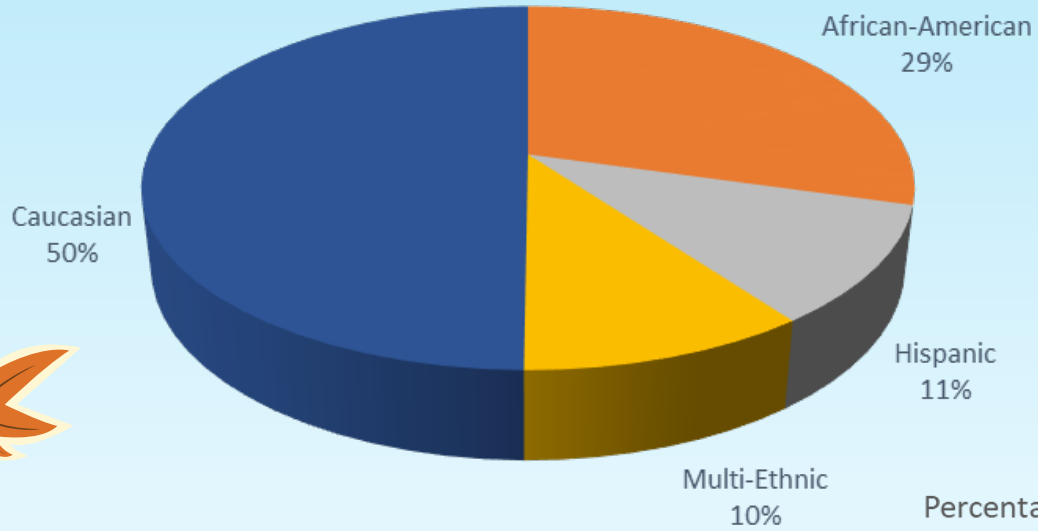
Based on SY2021-22, Survey II student information downloaded data, dated 10-15-2021

- This proposal increases the number of students within a 2-mile walking radius.
- One bus can accommodate all the students.
- No cross walks on Barna Avenue at River Oaks Dr. or Sun Valley St.; however, neither crossing meets the criteria to be a hazard for crossing an uncontrolled crossing site.
- The proposal decreases the number of riders, but not the number of buses used.
- This scenario has no effect on bus rides over 45 minutes.

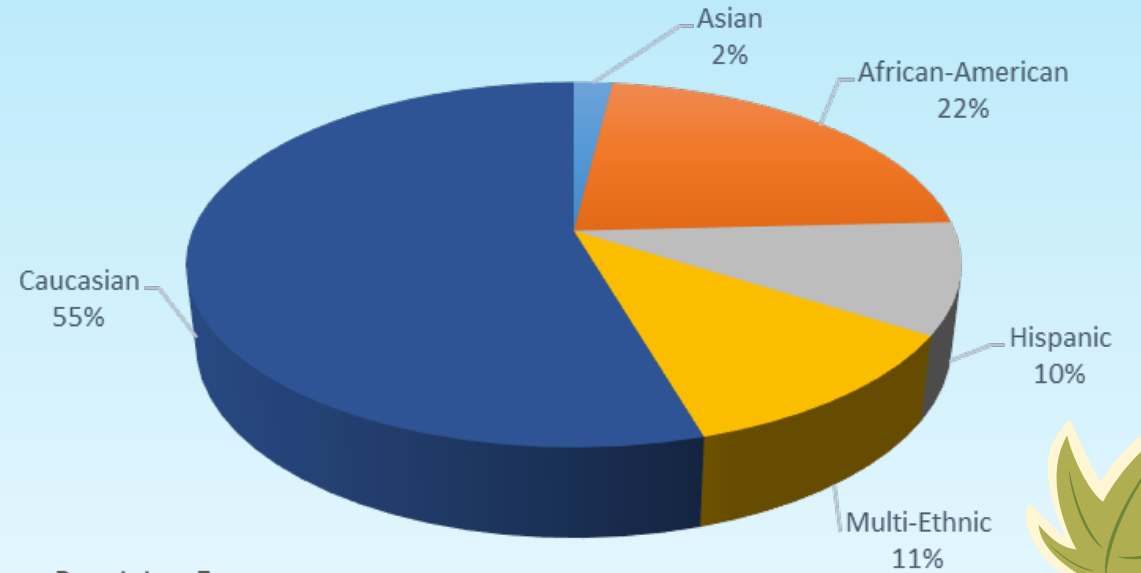

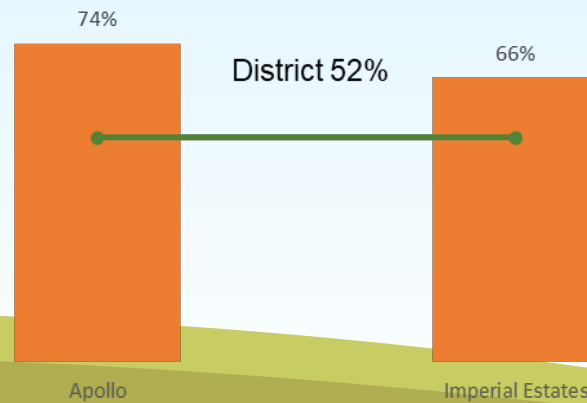

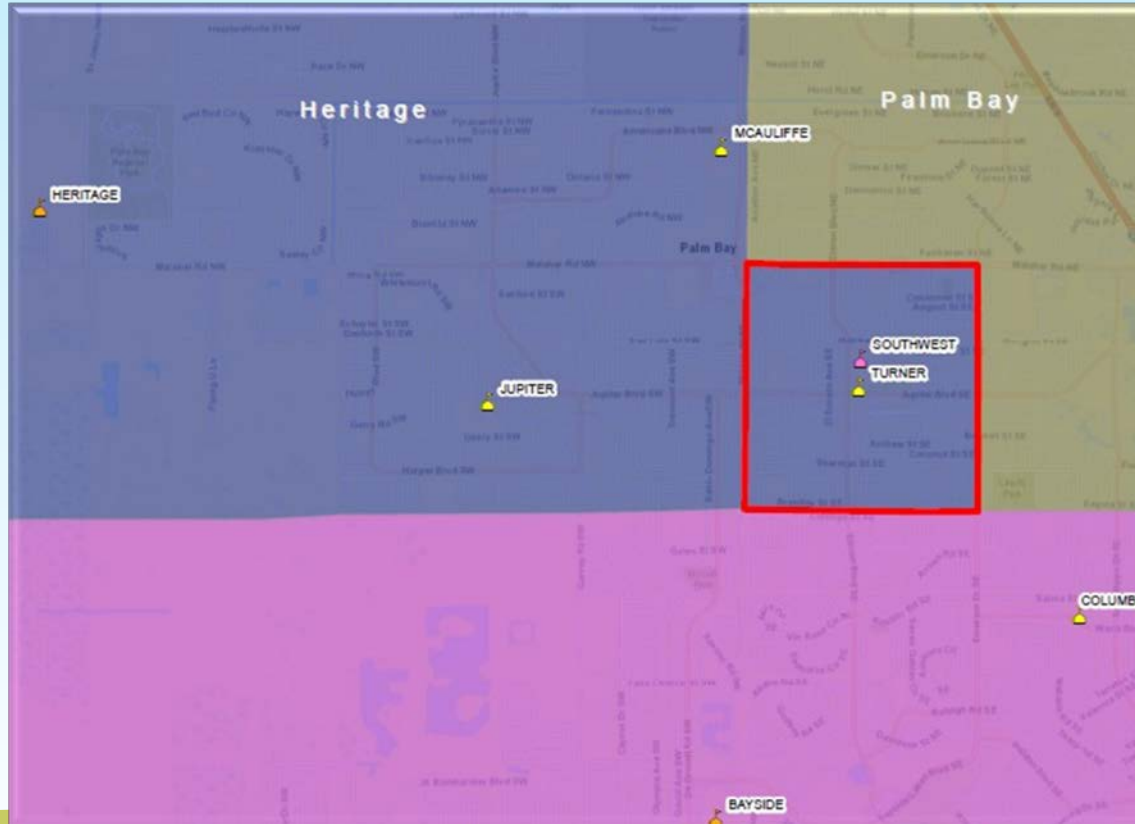

The intent of this proposal is to adjust the boundaries to better balance enrollment between Heritage and Bayside to accommodate near term growth.

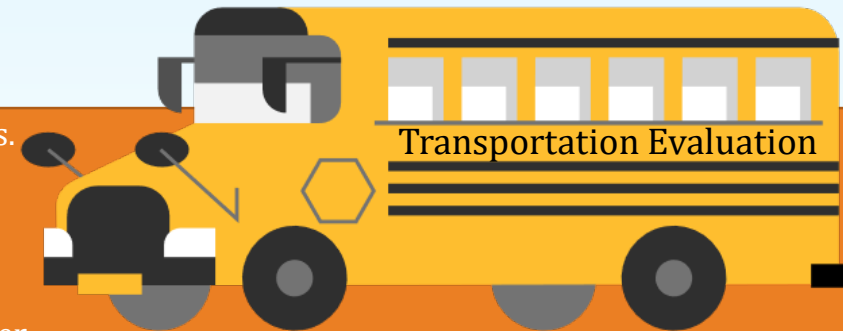
Heritage High to Bayside High School

- 197 students affected
- Expected Residential Growth
1,550 residential units planned for construction (248 high school students into Heritage High School over the next 5 years).
- Future Growth along St. Johns Heritage Parkway
1,229 units under preliminary review (197 potential high school students into Heritage High School)

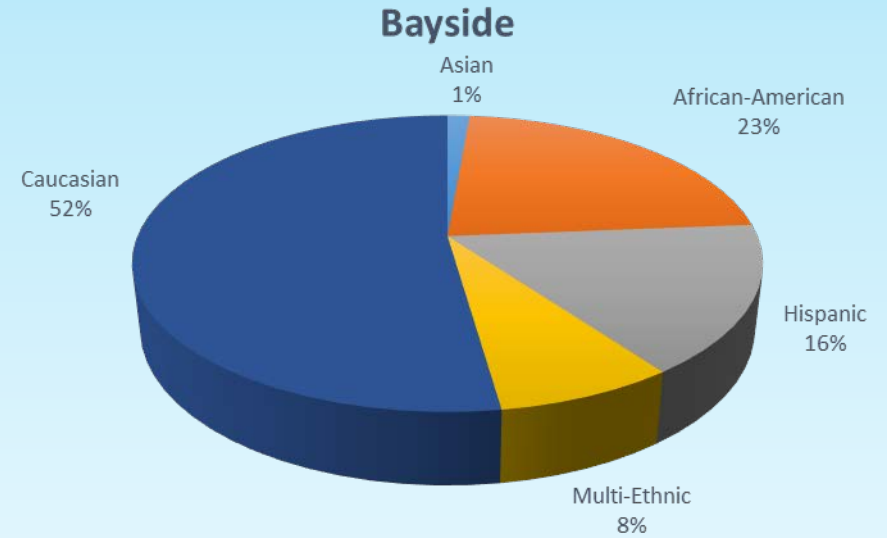
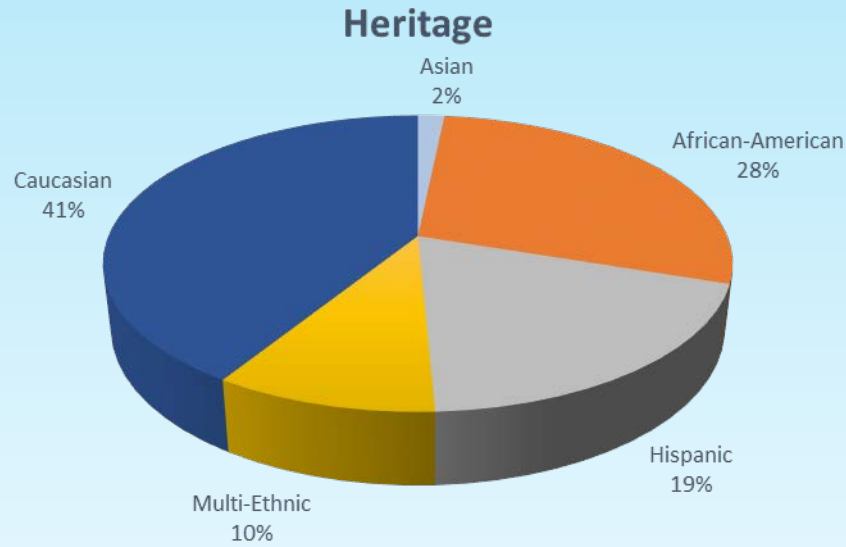

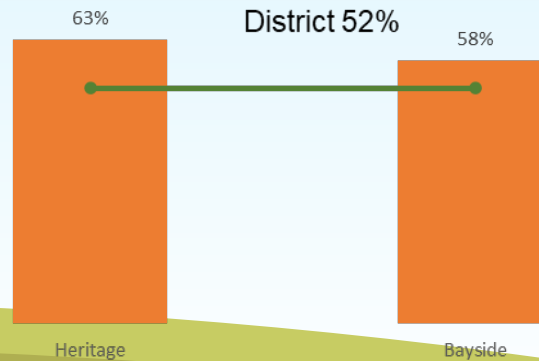
- This proposal does not change the number of students within a 2-mile walking radius.
- All students would be eligible for a bus.
- No special transportation considerations are necessary.
- The same number of students would be bused to Bayside, currently 3 buses, 1 inclusion bus, and 1 ESE bus service the area.
- This scenario has no effect on bus rides over 45 minutes, the bus ride would be shorter.



Heritage High to Bayside High School



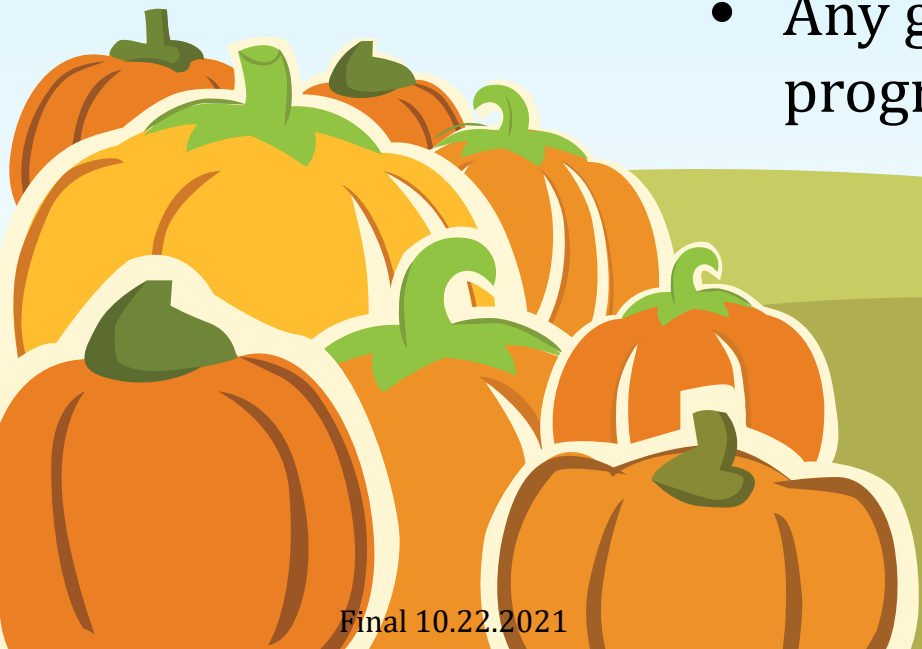
Percentage of Students Receiving Free or Reduced Lunch

The intent of this proposal is to better serve students of military families at Patrick Space Force Base. The proposal will align with the elementary school boundary so that Base siblings will be attending school in the same area. The proposal will better balance enrollment among DeLaura/Satellite and Cocoa Beach Jr./Sr. High Schools.

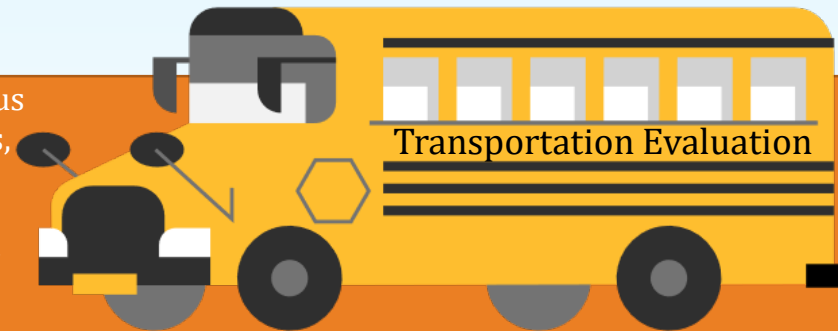
- One Community

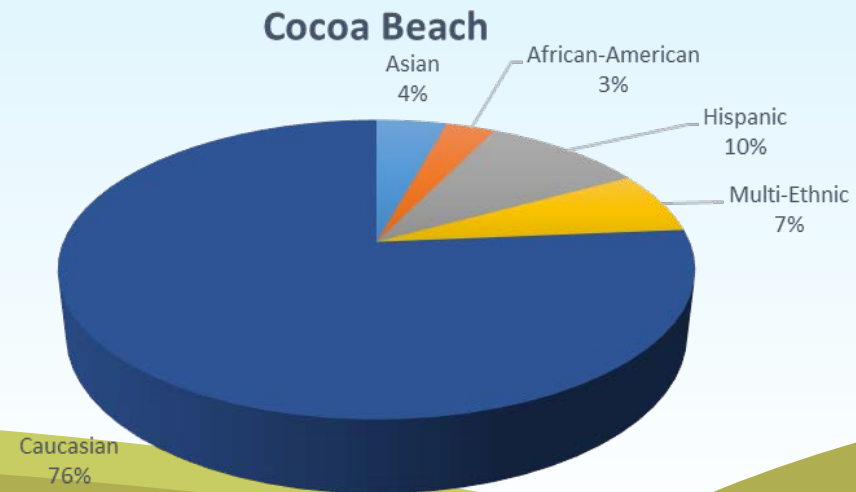
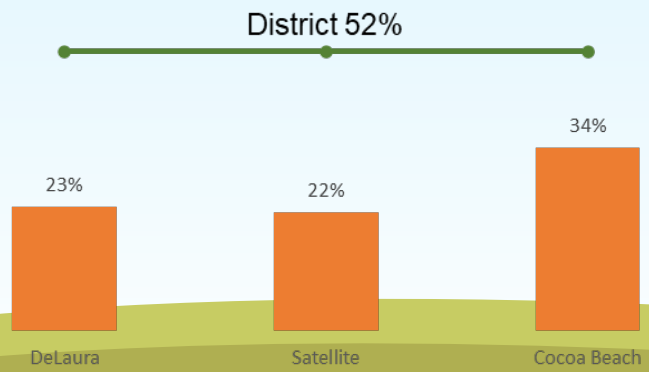
- This proposal does not change the number of students within a 2-mile walking radius
- Buses must use truck entrance onto Base and show ID; if a lockdown on Base occurs, Buses may not be able to enter/exit Base.
- No increase or decrease in the number of students riding a bus is expected.
- This scenario has no effect on bus rides over 45 minutes, rides may increase slightly over the existing routes, but only by a few minutes.
