

## CORE COURSES

Students must take 4 math classes. All students must take Algrebra 1 and Geometry. We offer Traditional, Honors, AP and IB levels.

Students must take 4 English classes. We offer Traditional, Honors, AP, and IB levels.

Students must take either 3 or 4 science courses. All students must take Biology. There are two science tracks available at either the Traditional, Honors, AP or IB levels.

### SOCIAL STUDIES - 3/4

Students must take either 3 or 4 Social Studies classes. Students must take US History, World History, US Government & Econ or the program equivalents for IB.

## MISCELANEOUS

## WORLD LANGUAGES - 2

Not a graduation requirement but required for entrance to a state four year college. Many schools want 3 or more years in a language sequence.

## TESTING

## FSA'S AND EOC'S

Students must take and pass their 10th grade ELA with a level 3 or higher. Students must take and pass the Algebra 1 EOC with a level 3 or higher.

## REQUIREMENTS

## ONLINE - 1

Students will need to take one of their 26 credits needed for graduation as an online course.

### HOPE - 1

Students will take one credit in Health Opportunities in Physical Education

### PERFORMING ARTS - 1

Students need one credit in performing arts, speech and debate or practical arts.

# CAREER RESEARCH AND **DECISION MAKING - .5**Students will take one-half credit in

Career Research. Can be taken online.

Students will need an additional 8.5 credits in various elective courses.

Students need a 2.0 GPA in order to graduate

# REQUIREMENT

Students need either 3 honors or higher level course or 3 CTE courses as part of thier 26 credits needed for graduation.
