










Lessons Passed Year-to-Date





7h 42m Average Lesson Time-on-Task per Student






DISCIPLINE REFERRALS

- 73 students have received referrals in first semester
 - Five students have 10-16 referrals (4 are K-2, one is 6th)
 - Six students have 5-9 referrals (1 is gr 2, 5 are grades 4-6)
 - Twenty-six students have more than 1 referral
 - Thirty-six have 1 referral

 - Multiracial 63%
 - Free/Reduced Lunch 45%




We have work to do...
