RED Project: Annotated Bibliography

Students are required to submit an annotated bibliography to Ms. Gallo by January 29th.

What is a bibliography? A list of sources used in the preparation of a paper, project, book, etc... (You had to include a bibliography every time you created a science fair project in elementary school.)

What is an annotated bibliography? An annotated bibliography is a list of citations to books, articles, and documents used during the creation of your project. Each citation is followed by a brief (usually about 150 words) descriptive and evaluative paragraph called the annotation. The purpose of the annotation is to inform the reader of the relevance, accuracy, and quality of the sources cited.

You must have a minimum of three (3) different sources. (Books, websites, magazines, videos, brochures, the list is endless.)

Your bibliography **must be in MLA format**. There are many websites you can use to create your annotated bibliography. Some we recommend are

- www.citationmachine.net
- www.bibme.org
- www.easybib.com (Warning, easybib has been acting odd lately. Use with caution.)
- You may use another website with which you are familiar as long as it allows you to create your bibliography in MLA format with annotations.

You have been given a sample annotated bibliography, so you know what one looks like. You have also been given the scoring rubric for the bibliography. Remember, this assignment counts as a test grade in Ms. Gallo's class, Mr. Gent's class, and Mrs. Korpas's class.

Your annotated bibliography is due Tuesday, January 29th.
