#### **Important Safety Information**

Please park in a parking space before coming into the front office. Pick up and Drop off is <u>not</u> permitted in the front parking lot/loop. Use the car loop on the South side of the school for arrival and dismissal.

When picking up your walkers, please do not park in Croton's parking lots or next door in the business parking lot.

The car loop gate opens at 2:20 Monday through Thursday, and 1:05 on Fridays. Please do not pull ahead of other cars already lined up.

At dismissal in the car loop students will be called by the youngest in the family. The older siblings need to listen for their names and go to their younger sibling's gate for pickup.



<u>Please remember no cell phone use,</u> <u>or smoking while in the car loop.</u>



Please keep your phone numbers updated with the Front Office. It's important for us to have your most current phone number. Please NOTE: Changes to student transportation need to be made in writing.





#### **Important Message** from the Clinic

Parents, please remember when your child is not feeling well it is important to keep them at home.

Also, please avoid giving your child fever reducing medication in the morning. If sent home with a fever, students must be fever free for 24 hours before returning to school.

## Rainy Day Plans

Dismissal Procedures for Rainy Day /Severe Weather

Brevard County 30-30 Rule - If the time between seeing lightning and hearing thunder is thirty (30) seconds or less, the outdoor l activity (including dismissal) shall be suspended immediately, and staff must wait thirty (30) minutes or more before allowing students to leave proper shelter.

If it is necessary to utilize Severe Weather Procedures as outlined in the Brevard County 30-30 Rule, an automated phone message will be sent to the phone number you list as your home phone, and ALL STUDENTS WILL REMAIN IN THE BUILDING.

Once the 30 minutes have passed, any walkers/bikers who have *"ride home in a car" indicated as their rainy day plan* will go to the i car loop for pickup. All other walkers/bikers will be dismissed once the weather is clear enough for safe passage home. Car loop will proceed as normal.

#### Annual Asbestos Notification

Brevard Public Schools' records indicate that no asbestos removal activities have taken place at Croton Elementary School during the past year (July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024).

#### **Background Information:**

The EPA Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of 1986 required an asbestos inspection of each school facility nationwide. This inspection was completed in 1988. The scope of the survey included sampling building materials that might contain asbestos, assessing the condition of materials, performing laboratory analysis of each sample, and writing a comprehensive report called an Asbestos Management Plan.
