**Dismissal Procedures for Rainy Day** /Severe Weather

#### Insure Student Safety and Facilitate Student Achievement

If it is necessary to utilize Severe Weather Procedures as outlined in the Brevard County 30-30 Rule, an automated phone message will be sent to the phone number you list as your home phone, and ALL STUDENTS WILL REMAIN IN THE BUILDING.

Once the 30 minutes have passed, any walkers/bikers who have "ride home in a car" indicated as their rainy day plan will go to the car loop for pickup. All other walkers/bikers will be dismissed once the weather is clear enough for safe passage home. Car loop will proceed as normal.

### Annual Asbestos Notification

Brevard Public Schools' records indicate that no asbestos removal activities have taken place at Croton Elementary School during the past year (July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022).

#### **Background Information:**

The EPA Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of 1986 required an asbestos inspection of each school facility nationwide. This inspection was completed in 1988. The scope of the survey included sampling building materials that might contain asbestos, assessing the condition of materials, performing laboratory analysis of each sample, and writing a comprehensive report called an Asbestos Management Plan.
