If a student is not in school, then we cannot teach the student. One of the biggest issues at Croton is the attendance, early check-out, and tardy rates of our students. The change to our clocks (November 6) is an excellent opportunity to be reminded about the

importance of arriving to school every day on time. There are many research studies on attendance (including timeliness) as an indicator of school success. Students may arrive on campus at 7:30 a.m. and head to the cafeteria for a well-balanced breakfast. Children need breakfast to help with their developing brains and growing bodies. Interestingly, studies show that children who skip breakfast are tardy and absent from school more often than children who eat breakfast on a regular basis.

### **FOCUS** Pins


If you have not received your child's FOCUS pin, please contact your child's teacher. You may


### Brevard Public Schools Mentor Process

- 1. Fingerprints & background check with <u>BPS District Security</u> (Open Monday– Friday 8am– 4:15pm)- Fees waved!
- 2. Online Mentor Training Modules
- 3. Choose a school and connect with the School Mentor Coordinator (SMC) for next steps:
  - ⇒ SMC sets1st meeting with mentor only. Give brief campus tour, review mentor policies, and choose time & location for meetings.
  - ⇒ 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting- SMC is there to introduce the mentee to their mentor and then leave them at the predetermined meeting location
