## Parent Feedback for recent surveys





<u>Survey Results for Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP)</u> - There were 32 surveys completed (including three Spanish and one Portuguese version). Input provided will be used when completing the 2023 -2024 PFEP. **Here are a few things we heard back from YOU!** 

To help families feel welcome and included, suggestions were made to be sure all families are represented and thought of when the scheduling of events and meetings occur, utilize ALL communication methods (email, text, phone, website, paper notices), and provide translators and translated documents for those needing them.

Suggestions for activities/trainings for families to help their children with reading and math included fun games (we hope you were able to attend our Math Night!) and offering tutoring support for families.

With respect to communication, many families felt that Croton is currently communicating well and they appreciate the texts and emails with information. Suggestions included more communication from teachers regarding student academic and behavior progress.

Suggested trainings for teachers and staff members in regard to communication included diversity training and training that provides support with communicating with families whose children have a medical diagnosis that affects the child's learning.

About half of the surveys returned showed an understanding of our Title I program and the other half showed that those families do not understand our Title I program. If you were unable to attend our Title I Annual Meeting where we explained all about what Title I means for our school, please visit Croton's website under the "Parents" section. You'll find a recording of the presentation that will help to explain many of the areas involved with Title I. If you still have questions about Title I, please feel free to contact the school.

<u>Survey results for the Croton Compact</u> - There were 29 surveys completed (including two Spanish and one Portuguese version). We also looked back at the 2022-2023 Title I Family-based Needs Assessment survey for input. Suggestions for our 2023-2024 Croton Compact included:



- For the Student Responsibility section, families feel that students should be Active Learners, complete homework, be respectful of self and school, and attend school regularly.
- For the At Home section, families feel that reading at home with children is important, families should monitor that homework is being completed, and open communication with teachers and the school should be maintained.
- ♦ For the **In the Classroom** section, most surveys showed a preference for providing feedback about student progress and utilizing small group instruction.
- For the **Communication** section, responses were similar to the responses in the PFEP surveys. Direct contact from teachers regarding student academic and behavior progress is preferred.


