Prior SAC meeting Minutes Review & Approval

Mrs. Branstetter motioned to approve the minutes of the January 18, 2023 meeting, and all approved the motion.

Thornton – Castaldo: Stakeholder Input Needed for Non-Fiction Book Order

Mrs. Castaldo requested that Ms. Thornton share with SAC her request for stakeholder input. Thornton shared 'the new state statute says library orders need to offer stakeholders, including parents, input before an order is placed. BPS, like many districts, will have its SAC serve as the school's stakeholders. Library media specialist (LMS) will need to work with their principal and SAC chair to be added to the SAC agenda and to share the booklist. Stakeholders will have the opportunity at a SAC meeting to share their input. Once the committee has met, input shared with the LMS, then books may be ordered.'

Mrs. Castaldo plans to prepare a book order and present to SAC at its March meeting. Thornton also shared that the nonfiction section of the media center needs to be updated with newer, engaging titles; the majority of the budget will be spent on this genre.

Mrs. Thornton – iReady Data Minutes/Percentage Passing Rates

Thornton reviewed the below data with members and that students are asked to engage with iReady 45 minutes a week for reading and 45 minutes for math. Dodd shared that she monitors domain shut-offs bi weekly; domains are turned-on if off at this time.

Mrs. Keane – Youth Truth Survey

Keane shared the Youth Truth Survey is designed to give students a voice; Mrs. Keane continued by explaining the survey questioning and the types of questions asked. The areas covered on the survey and Cape View's percentile rank are as follows: Engagement, 33rd; Academic Challenges, 10th; Instructional Methods, 21st; Belonging, 28th; Culture, 10th; Relationships, 30th; and Project Based Learning, 25th (math section).

Mrs. Keane and Dr. Mela, ESEA Title I, met to review grade level performance, it was shared that Academic Challenges and Culture were Cape View's lowest areas, areas break down to grade levels. 3rd grade was a focus of this meeting as well, and the substitute's third grade class is currently outperforming Lueders' third grade class as evidenced by FAST data.

Mrs. Brooks – FAST Growth Report

Mrs. Brooks shared FAST data and stated, 'FAST data shows growth for every grade level; we are right where we need to be for 3rd grade reading.' She added that Cape View's Star Reading for K-2 increased for PM2 (progress monitoring #2).

Mrs. Keane added that more growth needs to be made in the area of math although math is showing some growth based on current data.

Ms. Thornton shared math strategies that she is using with her 2nd grade students; and Mrs. Berry added that the new math curriculum is very complex and challenging as compared to math in prior years during her tenure.

Ms. Thornton – St. David's by The Sea Fundraiser

Ms. Thornton shared St. David's by the Sea Fundraiser; this business partner is holding its annual yard sale on February 10 from 8:00-2:00 and again on February 11 from 9:00-2:00. All are invited to attend.

Mrs. Branstetter – PTO Basket Fundraiser

Mrs. Branstetter shared that grade level baskets will be created by asking parents to send in items to be placed in 'themed baskets.' Mrs. Branstetter will wrap each themed basket in cellophane and hold an auction at her place of employment, Wal Mart Distribution Center, to raise funds for Cape View. The last day to turn in donation will be March 27.

Input (Open Forum):

Mrs. Keane shared there will be a BPS Job Fair on February 14 from 8:30-11:00; the district is looking for bus drivers, cafeteria workers, custodians and others.

Thornton shared the next meeting will be March 8, 2023.

The meeting adjourned at 4:16.

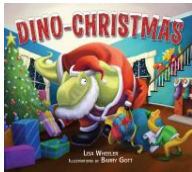
