


## 2023-2024 Brevard County Public Title I Schools

School academic goal(s) and/or focus area(s)

Through collaborative planning sessions, teachers and staff will develop learning tasks and plan for small group instruction aligned to Florida's Benchmarks for Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards to improve student proficiency in English Language Arts, with a targeted focus on the performance of subgroups.

Working together for success:
In the classroom

Teachers and staff will implement standards-based, high-quality lessons and assessments. Additionally, teachers will instruct in a supportive learning environment that enables all students to reach academic success. Teachers will regularly assess students and use data to refine and modify instruction as needed. Teachers and staff will discuss/explain curriculum and data with families during Open House, parent/teacher conferences, and/or anytime mutually agreed upon by all. All faculty members will build positive relationships with families by demonstrating respect, sensitivity and understanding.

Working together for success:
At home

Information about academic curriculum, B.E.S.T. Standards and academic assessments used to measure student performance as well as achievement levels will be shared with families during our Annual Title I Meeting, Open House, parent/teacher conferences, Grade Level Curriculum Events, Title I Parent and Family Involvement Events, FOCUS, and/or on Discovery's website. During Curriculum and Parent and Family Involvement Events, families will be given resources in specific content areas to successfully work with their child at home.

Working together for success:
Student responsibility

Students will take ownership of their learning by setting goals for themselves based on their strengths and weaknesses. Students will be responsible for their own education by monitoring their goals, as well as being prepared for class each day. Students will demonstrate respect to their peers and all faculty members of the school.

**Communication:** Staying informed

All staff members will maintain an open line of communication with families by utilizing various platforms, such as FOCUS, ClassDojo, classroom newsletters and/or the student planner. The school will communicate to families via FOCUS, the monthly school calendar, the monthly school newsletter, ClassDojo, and our school website. Families will be able to check their child's progress, convey concerns, and/or access information via these communication methods.

Building Partnerships Discovery Elementary will provide multiple opportunities for families to become involved in their child's education. Academic events will be held at least once a month to support families when working at home with their child, as well as allow families to gain a better understanding of the curriculum being taught. Discovery will also provide families with resources and strategies that can be used at home, including literacy, math, and science materials. Additionally, staff members will offer families community resources when needed.
