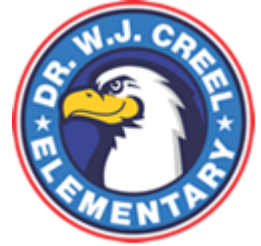

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| <p>School academic goal(s) and/or focus area(s)</p> | <p>Teachers and staff will collaborate and provide best instructional practices, focusing on benchmark-aligned instruction to achieve and increase student proficiency and mastery in ELA, math, and science on state tests. Teachers and staff will also collaborate and provide best instructional practices in teaching life skills.</p> |
| <p>Working together for success: In the classroom</p> | <p>Teachers and staff will provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that supports students in meeting the Florida State Standards. Parents and families will be given an overview of "What Their Child is Expected to Learn" for their child's specific grade level. Through parent and family involvement events, parents and families will be given resources in each content area that align with the Florida State Standards to be able to successfully work with their child at home and to engage them in a love of learning.</p> |
| <p>Working together for success: At home</p> | <p>Teachers and staff will maintain records of student academic progress and inform students, parents, and families through FOCUS, interims, progress reports, and parent/teacher conferences about individual student progress. Parents and families will be encouraged to check student planners and review graded work and assignments to promote academic achievement. Parents and families will also ensure students maintain regular attendance and are on time to school.</p> |
| <p>Working together for success: Student responsibility</p> | <p>Students will share the responsibility to improve academic achievement by coming prepared for class and completing classwork and homework assignments. Students will be responsible for monitoring their learning, asking for help when needed, and believing in themselves to try and do their personal best.</p> |
| <p>Communication: Staying informed</p> | <p>Teachers and families will use student planners, parent/teacher conferences, and technology platforms such as See Saw, Google Classroom, FOCUS, Dr. W.J. Creel Facebook Page, and S'more Newsletters from administration to families. There will also be an Open House and Title 1 Annual Meeting once a year.</p> |
| <p>Building Partnerships</p> | <p>Parents and families can participate in school activities like Open House Scavenger Hunt, Bingo for Books Literacy Night, STEAM and Treat Math and Science Night, Fill Your Belly with Spaghetti Holiday Dinner, Popcorn and Pajamas Reading Night, and the Prevent the Summer Slide End of Year Carnival. Parents and families can also sign up to volunteer in classrooms and to serve on school committees like SAC and PTO.</p> |
