GRADING AND RANKING

EXTERNAL EXAMINATIONS

CAMBRIDGE ASSESSMENT INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION

During the June 2023 testing session, 413 Cambridge students were tested in 751 exams. There were 93 students entered for the AICE Diploma with 54% earning it, 25 with Merit.




OTHER ADVANCED PROGRAMS (DUAL ENROLLMENT)

In the Fall, 95 students tested in 215 courses at Eastern Florida State College

with 46% of students passing with an A, 31% of students passing with a B, and 11% passing with a C.



In the Spring, 104 students tested in 204 courses at Eastern Florida State College; 44% of students passing with an A, 31% of students passing with a B, 12% of students passing with a C.
