












Florida Academic Scholar Award & the AICE Diploma



Florida Academic Scholar Award is the highest level of Bright Futures Scholarship

(In 2019 a student earning the FAS received full tuition at any Florida public university for fall, spring and summer semesters as well as a \$300 stipend for textbooks/materials for each fall and spring semester. Students can use the money towards 160 credit hours at the university.)

Rubric involves:

- Test Scores: EOC/Iowa State Test/FSA
- 2 Teacher Recommendations (M/LA)
- Any high school courses completed in middle school? (Math, Foreign Language)
- Middle School GPA







- 1. If you are **not** zoned for Eau Gallie High School, complete online application located through the OPEN ENROLLMENT section of the Brevard Public School website
- 2. If not zoned for Eau Gallie High, you will need to pay the \$30 fee
- 3. If you are zoned for Eau Gallie High, you will complete the Open Enrollment online application located on the front page of our school website

All applications open January4, 2021 and close February 26, 2021
