I agree to keep talking, playing, or socializing to a minimum during practice. Repeated interruption will result in a written warning note home. If the behavior occurs again, I will be removed from choir.

I agree to work as a team and to be willing to sit, stand, or work with any member of choir even if I don't know them very well.

I realize that I must be in the carline on time to pick up my child. If I am late more than three times, I will be dismissed from choir. Parents are required to be in the car rider line at 2:00 on their Choir rehearsal day. Do not enter the building to pick up your child. We will walk the students to the car rider line area at 2:00 and loading will begin.

Friends and siblings are not allowed to stay for practice.

Gum, cellphones, and food are not allowed in practices. Cellphones are allowed outside in the carline if your child needs to contact you.

I agree to wearing my choir uniform for every performance. All Choir participants must purchase a t-shirt and will be required to wear their choir shirt with khaki pants at all performances.


