- Launch date: Aug. 29, 2022
- Mission duration: 42 days, 3 hours, 20 minutes
- Total distance traveled: 1.3 million miles
- Re-entry speed: 24,500 mph (Mach 32)
- Splashdown: Oct. 10, 2022

Freedom 7 capsule Facts

- Launch Date: May 5, 1961
- Mission duration: 15 minutes 22 seconds
- Total distance traveled: +300 miles, 116 miles above Earth
- Shepard manned Freedom 7 and 10 years later flew on Apollo to the moon
- Splashdown: May 5, 1961


Want to beat traffic and watch the Artemis launch?

5 ways you could support your child as a PYP parent

As an essential member of your child's learning community, you play an important role helping them take their learning deeper. Here are 5 simple ways you can support your child's learning at home. Whether it is the more formal learning connected to their schooling, or the incidental, unplanned learning through play, exploration and life experience; these 5 strategies will help you, help your child become a lifelong learner.



Support conceptual understanding

VALUE PROCESS

How did you do that? Why did you do that? What strategy did you use?

HARNESS THE POWER OF KEY CONCEPTS What does it look like? [Form] *Turn page for key concepts*

Support your child's agency

INVITE AND INVOLVE THEIR VOICE Let them express themselves

SUPPORT THEIR CHOICES What choice are you making for yourself as a learner?

EMPHASISE OWNERSHIP You're in the driver's seat

Prioritise reflection

GET THEM THINKING ABOUT THEIR THINKING How do you know? What makes you think that? Is there another way that you could do that? What did you find easy or challenging? Why?

Give feedback that goes beyond the moment

TEACH THE LEARNER, NOT THE LEARNING Move from asking How are you doing? to Where to next?

GIVE SPECIFIC FEEDBACK ON THE PROCESS

I like how you did... What might you try doing next?

Take an inquiry stance

MEET A QUESTION WITH A QUESTION How could you find that out?

BE PREPARED TO INQUIRE TOGETHER Let's figure it out together!

ASK AN OPEN-ENDED QUESTION What do you notice?

BE A LEARNER Here is how I'm going to find out

Enrichment Class General Information


What are enrichment classes?

- Enrichment classes are classes for children to participate in through the school's BAS program.
- All enrichment classes are instructed by outside companies. All instructors are background screened, drug tested, and trained by the BAS district office prior to being cleared to conduct classes in the BAS program.
- All classes are held on campus and overseen by the BAS staff. Instructors are expected to follow the BAS procedures for safety and discipline during class time.

How do I register my child?

- You must register your child in the BAS program <u>and</u> the enrichment program. After paying the \$25.00 registration fee for BAS you will only need to pay the monthly enrichment class fee unless your child attends the BAS program outside of the enrichment class time.
- If you are not using weekly BAS program services, you will be registered in the Daily Drop-In BAS program. This will allow your child to attend the BAS program in the case of an emergency or whenever you need them to at the rate of \$29.00 per day.
- If your child is not picked up from BAS within 5 minutes of the end of the enrichment class time they will be checked into BAS and you will be charged \$29.00 for that day.
- Registration is a first come first serve basis.
- Enrichment class registration is on a monthly basis. When registering you will pay for the full month and continue paying by the due date each month unless you choose to withdraw your child from the class. All fees are non-refundable and make up classes are not offered for children that are absent the day of the class. If you have not paid by the due dates each month your child will be dropped from the class.


Fees:


