The art teacher at Cocoa Beach Jr.Sr. High School, Sara Soto, reached out to our school's Art teacher, Lexie VanVuren, in an effort to make meaningful connections between her artists and our artists. She came to us with a project idea. We would have the Kindergarten artists each create a drawing of a character, with as many details as possible. In turn, her high school artists would create a 3D version of each drawing. The artists would meet to collaborate and share ideas.

Words to describe the learning: working with a fellow artist collaborator, communicating ideas, visual language, relationship building, innovative ideas, creating a art piece with a client (kindergarteners are like the clients). In addition, skills reinforced include: organizing and developing ideas, refining and completing an artwork, interpreting another artist's vision, synthesizing and relating knowledge. All of this based on the artists' personal experiences used to express themselves through art and deepen understanding of the media of clay and form. Making such meaningful connections strengthens and builds community. We look forward to seeing the 3D forms created and another opportunity to connect.
