Dear Families,

Next FriYAY, February 3, 2023... have your child bring anything they wish to play with to school. The only restrictions: they must bring toys and these toys may NOT require batteries or electricity. No devices. No scooters or skateboards for safety reasons or any other toy you feel may cause concern.


