

The Learner Profile, Risk-Taker

Students who are RISK-TAKERS dare to try new things. They try to solve problems in a variety of ways. How can parents help to develop students who are Risk-Takers at home?

- If your child is feeling uneasy about trying something new, encourage them to attempt it
 and then reflect on both whether they liked the activity and how it felt to try something
 new.
- Your child might want to set some short-term goals. Consider activities new to him/her.
 Your child might set a goal to:
 - -Offer an opinion in class
 - Spend one recess with someone they might not usually play with
 - Order something different from the lunch menu
 - Try an activity or food that they haven't tried before
- Be careful to explain to your child the difference between being a risk-taker by trying new things versus doing dangerous things.
