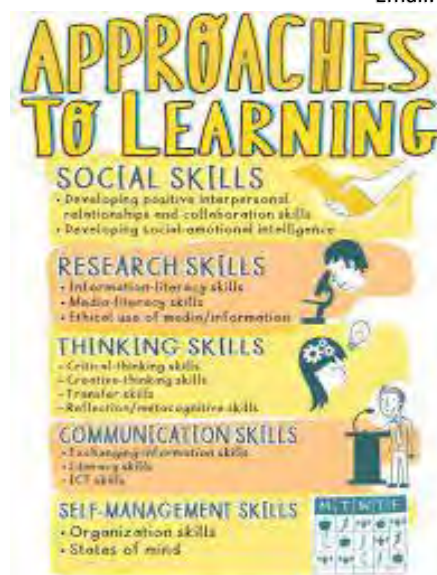
IB Learner Profile & Approaches to Learning

Development of the IB Learner Profile attributes and the Approaches to Learning skills in all learners is at the heart of all things PYP. These attributes and skills are what our Program of Inquiry works to instill in our learners, in the hope that they will leave us as responsible internationally minded citizens who seek to take action to make the world a better place! According to a research study conducted in 2020 by a team from ACER (Australian Council for Educational Research), “the learner profile and ATL (Approaches to Learning) are key programmatic elements that may already encourage well-being in PYP schools.” Furthermore, the schools in which research was conducted “consistently showed a more positive school climate and higher levels of teacher engagement, student participation in ATL-rich classrooms, and student well-being outcomes, attributable to the PYP.” This study is a refreshing reminder of the many positive outcomes of the IB PYP Program.

Local Giveback: What makes this program unique is that for every pack of socks sold, you will also receive a pair of socks for donation to a local organization of our choice.

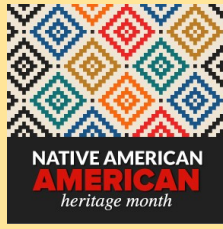

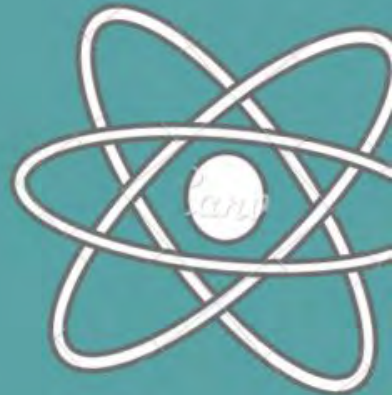
