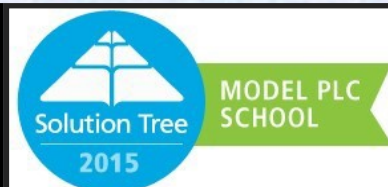

IB Primary Years Programme Update

This week, we completed our five-year IB PYP site evaluation visit! This is the culmination of a year-long Self-Study process where our school community purposefully reflects on the PYP Program implementation. In addition, an extensive list of preliminary review documents had to be prepared and submitted to the IB evaluation team and feedback was given. The site visit finalizes the process, and then within a few months, a formal report is sent to school leaders. This was a virtual visit with a team of IB trained evaluators. The process involved a detailed evaluation of our school's demonstration of the IB Program Standards and Practices. During this three-day process, teams of Administrators, District leaders, teachers, parents and students participated in group interviews focused on these standards and practices. It was an opportunity for us to demonstrate growth as an IB PYP school since our last visit in 2018. Collectively, we were able to share many of our school's highlights related to school Culture, Learning, Purpose and Environment. We also shared reflections related to our Program Development Goals. It was a meaningful process. We were provided an overview of feedback from our evaluation team regarding our strengths and areas for further development of the program. We appreciate everyone in the entire school community. It takes a village, and together we are making the PYP happen for our students!
