they can only use water fountains as water bottle filling stations

### Strings Information

#### Happy Friday!

Your students are extremely excited to begin strings classes! That said, strings will look a little different than normal this year, but we will definitely have beginning strings and intermediate strings available. Instead of before/after/during school instruction and mixing all classes, we will have strings for ALL beginning students in 5th and 6th grades during their regularly scheduled music class during the day. All students may participate at no cost to you. Your student will receive a full school year of free strings instructions, which is a very nice perk! Our goal is to provide quality music instruction while allowing for fun and community building while preparing them for either 7th grade orchestra or intermediate strings class here at Freedom 7 next year.

Intermediate strings will meet at the following times: Friday during the day (Day 0) 1:40-2:10 Wednesday mornings 8:00-8:45

Mitigations in place for strings classes:

- Students will sanitize upon entering and exiting the music room.
- All instruments, class equipment, and furniture will be sanitized between classes.
- Students will be seated around the same students as in their homeroom classes.
- Masks will be encouraged in the music room.

All Students will have access to instruments (violin, viola, cello, bass) at Freedom 7. If a student uses a school instrument, it will need to remain on campus as it will be a sanitized, shared instrument. If your student owns their own instrument or rents an instrument from a music store, they will not share that instrument and will take it home daily allowing for further practice.

All 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders will start strings classes at the beginning of the next 6 day rotation. Day 1 will be Tuesday, August 31<sup>st</sup>. From this time on, when your child's class has music activity, that will be their strings class. Please have them bring their instrument that day.
