

## Essential Agreements in the PYP



September 10, 2021

You may have had your child come home talking about the Essential Agreements of their classrooms. Essential Agreements are a critical part of the learning environment in PYP classrooms. Unlike rules, Essential Agreements are co-created between the teacher and students. This process allows students to have their voice heard in how the classroom will function and flow. There are many creative ways teachers do this with students, and often the IB PYP Learner Profile is at the heart of creation of these agreements. Teachers may ask students things like what does learning look like, sound like, and feel like? It's important that everyone knows that the agreements are a living document that can be amended and changed as the class agrees. Ask your child about his or her Essential Agreements, and who knows, you may even consider creating some for your home environment. We know that the more ownership and voice students have in cocreating their learning environments, the more buy-in they are likely to have.
