Principal's Message



Dear Families,

We are excited to support Global School PLAY DAY on February 3, 2023 for the 4th time. This is a grassroots effort created by educators in support of unstructured playtime for students around the world. In 2019 we joined over 563,000 children! How can you support the day? Have your child bring anything they wish to play with to school on Friday, February 3, 2023. The only restrictions: they must bring toys and these toys may NOT require batteries or electricity. No devices. Some items may be: board games, dolls, Legos, blocks, trucks, cars, racetracks, playing cards, empty cardboard boxes, markers, jigsaw puzzles, blankets (for forts), social games (charades, Pictionary, etc.). The only exception on the electronics rule would be a board game that has an electronic timer, an electronics play kit, or similar. They will be playing outside all while being supervised by all staff at Freedom 7. We recommend putting names on items when possible. Also, applying sunscreen and sending hats, sunglasses and/or outerwear for outdoor activities is highly recommended. Students will wear their grade level colored shirt with uniform bottoms and shoes. Finally, please don't forget those refillable water bottles, our students need to stay hydrated. **PLAY! NO SCREENS - NO STRUCTURE - ALL DAY LONG #GSPD2023**
