Students are encouraged to become critical and open-minded thinkers, lifelong learners and compassionate world citizens who respect cultural diversity and take action to better our world.

## The Learner Profile, Reflective

Students who are REFLECTIVE know what they are good at and what they need to work on. They try to think about these things and make changes where they can. They give thoughtful consideration to their own learning and consider their personal strengths and weaknesses in a constructive manner. *How can parents help to develop students who are Reflective at home?*

- Spend some time reviewing your child's report card with them. Discuss their thoughts on their strengths and areas for improvement.
- Consider goals that your child could set for the next term. Make a list of not only the goals, but specific actions that could be taken to achieve these goals. You might want to list actions that your child will take independently as well as actions parents will take to support them. For example, if one of the goals your child sets is to improve their writing, their action might be to keep a journal and write in it for at least 10 minutes each night. As a parent, you might decide that the two of you will participate in shared writing for 30 minutes each week and produce a book of narratives together.

Encourage your student to reflect on their behavior and actions. Should they have responded to a situation differently? If so, why do they think they responded the way they did? What can they do differently next time?




- ELO/EPO Renewal will be used for current BPS students that will be renewing at the same school as an ELO or EPO.
