The Learner Profile, Reflective

Students who are REFLECTIVE know what they are good at and what they need to work on. They try to think about these things and make changes where they can. They give thoughtful consideration to their own learning and consider their personal strengths and weaknesses in a constructive manner. How can parents help to develop students who are Reflective at home?

- Spend some time reviewing your child's report card with them. Discuss their thoughts on their strengths and areas for improvement.
- Consider goals that your child could set for the next term. Make a list of not only the goals, but specific actions that could be taken to achieve these goals. You might want to list actions that your child will take independently as well as action parents will take to support them. For example, if one of the goals your child sets is to improve their writing, their action might be to keep a journal and write in it for at least 10 minutes each night. As a parent, you might decide that the two of you will participate in shared writing for 30 minutes each week and produce a book of narratives together.

Encourage your student to reflect on their behavior and actions. Should they have responded to a situation differently? If so, why do they think they responded the way they did? What can they do differently next time?







Welcome to the new Focus online ELO/EPO Renewal process. Here is some important information as you get access and complete the ELO/EPO Renewal document in Focus

- This is NOT a NEW application. This is for CURRENT students


