RE-ENROLLMENT

Re-enrollment for the 2023-2024 school year is to be completed in your child's Focus account. If you have never accessed your account or need assistance, please contact the front office. All students, including current sixth grade students, must re-enroll electronically. Directions are below.

After your application is processed, you will receive an alert message on your Focus portal page. Clicking the link will display the completed form and the approved/denied (if any) fields. Please note, it may be a few days before you receive the message. Thank you for your patience.

- All families *new only* to Brevard that are in a Choice program, must complete a paper packet. If you were in a BPS school last year you will do a re-enrollment application online.
- Sixth grade students must have the re-enrollment information completed and verified by Ms. Carol by June 20, 2023. Any students not enrolled will not be updated in FOCUS for their prospective middle schools.



On Monday, March 27th, a group of our fifth graders competed at the Destination Mars Competition. We are so proud of their diligence, teamwork, and commitment. For this competition, students were divided into two teams (Red Raiders and Superior Supernovas). To prepare, students worked on various missions that required them to develop their research, problem-solving, leadership, and presentation skills.

The missions included:

- LEGO Spike Prime Robot build and code a robot to complete various obstacles and create a research presentation
- Minecraft build a Mars base and support with research
- iWear code an AdaFruit circuit board and use it to create a wearable device to help astronauts maintain homeostasis
- Base Camp Pod create a 3D base camp pod to help astronauts overcome challenges on Mars
- Reporter create an iMovie presentation to show the overall engineering process using photos, interviews, and videos
