

Dear Parents:

As part of our ongoing improvement process, the <u>District</u> has reviewed our annual enrollment process. The following changes to are highlighted below.

- ✓ Simplified and condensed the amount of information being collected while ensuring that critical information is embedded in one process.
- ✓ Pre-populated information on sections that have already been provided to the <u>District</u>.
- ✓ Eliminated the need of two proofs of residence verification.
- ✓ Change of timeline from March to July.
- ✓ Modified language to make it more parent friendly.
- ✓ Reduced signatures from 11 to ONLY 1!
- ✓ Added <u>a</u> ENROLLMENT VERIFICATION form to assist schools with enrollment numbers.

At this time, your ENROLLMENT VERIFICATION is required. We ask that you take a few minutes to complete this process by logging on to your FOCUS account. The Annual Re-enrollment form will be available on July 8, 2024. All enrollment documents may be found under your child's name in the <u>forms</u> summary section.
