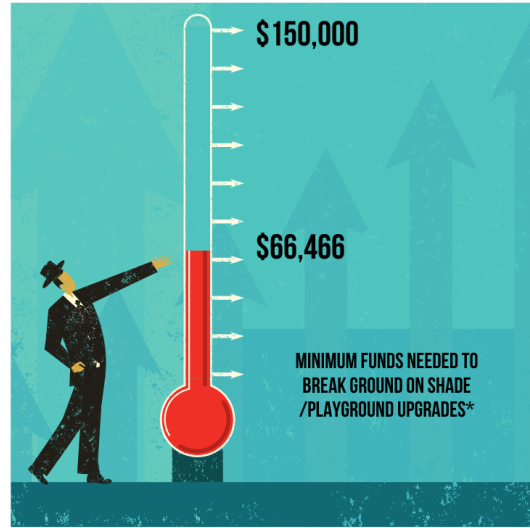
GOALS:

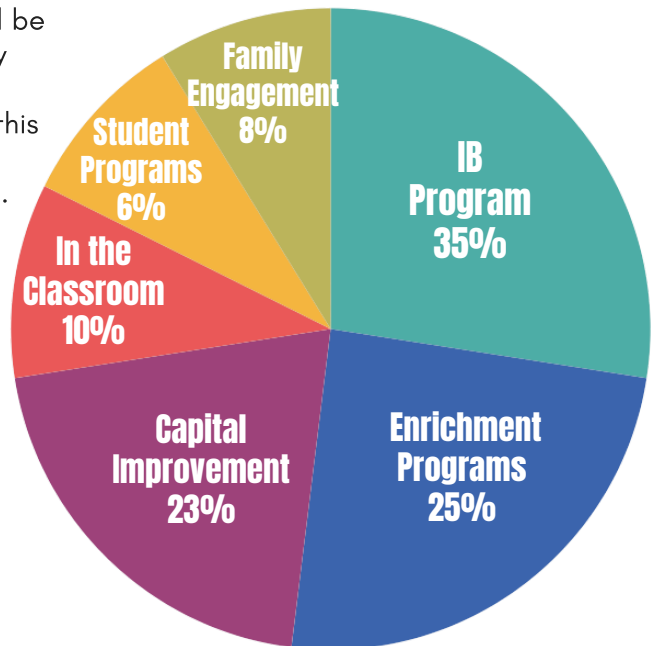

Help us maintain a healthy campus!

Child not feeling well? If you child is showing one or more of following symptoms please keep them home and follow the process below before their return.

Symptoms:

- fever
- chills
- congestion
- shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- fatigue
- muscle or body aches
- headache
- loss of teste/smell
- sore throat
- nausea/vomiting
- diarrhea



CDC guidelines require:

Remain home for 10 days from first sign of symptoms and report it to school.

1. Get a medical release from your child's doctor clearing them to return **OR**
2. Present negative Covid-19 test (MUST BE PCR- rapid will not release back them to school) **AND**
3. No fever (100.4 or higher) for at least 24 hours
