Students may wear:

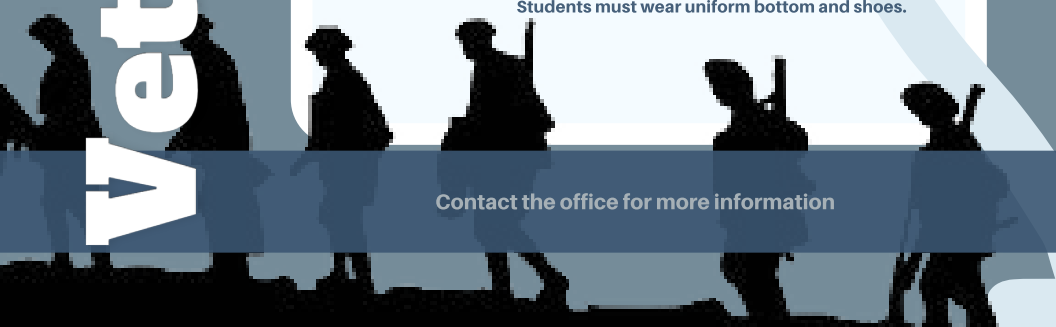
- A shirt with a branch of the military on it representing the Veteran(s) in their family
