Important Immunization Notice for Parents of All 6th Grade Students

Florida State Law requires that all students receive a T-dap booster immunization BEFORE entering 7th grade. Because this immunization is not required for elementary students, it is NOT part of your child's health records. DON'T DELAY! Students must have this immunization to register for middle school.



Registration for the 2018-2019 school year is happening now! Thank you to all of the families who have returned their children's 2018-2019 registration packets. This will eliminate the need to register during the summer. If you have not returned your child's packet or any required items, please do so as soon as possible. We want to assure your child has a class placement for the 2018-19 school year. Class placements will be sent home via US Mail during the second week of August, 2018.

If you have an incoming kindergartner, please return in his/her registration packet now as well. We are looking forward to meeting all of our new Holland Hornets!

School will begin for all 1st-6th grade students on August 10th, for all Kindergarten students on August 15th, and Pre-K on August 17th. We want to have as many registrations completed before this school year comes to a close in order to plan for a successful 2018-2019 school year!


