<p><b><i>Harry the Dirty Dog</i> by Gene Zion, read by Betty White</b>  <b>April 11th was National Pet Day</b>  <b>Before reading/listening:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● What are some things people do to care for pets?</li> <li>● Have you ever had to do something you didn't want to do, but needed to do it because it was good for you?</li> <li>● Predict- How do you think Harry will get dirty?</li> </ul>	<p><b>April is Poetry Month</b>  <b>Before reading/listening:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Think about- What is a poem?</li> <li>● What are some of the types of poems you know?</li> <li>● Words to know when reading Poetry: alliteration, assonance, onomatopoeia, simile, personification, metaphor</li> </ul>
<p>Read and listen to the book on <a href="#">Storyline Online</a>  <b>As you read/listen to the story:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Pause the video and make predictions             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Why is Harry hiding the scrub brush?</li> <li>○ Do you think somebody will find Harry?</li> <li>○ Will Harry's family recognize him?</li> <li>○ Why do you think Harry hid the scrub brush at the end?</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<p>Read or listen to some poems, <a href="#">CLICK HERE</a> or find some <a href="#">in this Collection</a>  <b>As you read/listen:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Think about- What is the message, theme, or image is the author sharing?</li> <li>● What does the poem mean to you? Does it create an image, make you feel an emotion?</li> </ul>
<p><b>After reading/listening:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Talk about what happened in the beginning, middle, and end of the story (summarize key ideas and details)</li> <li>● K-1st- divide a piece of paper into 3 columns, label first column beginning, second middle, third end. Have students draw a picture in each column to retell the story</li> <li>● 2nd- create a comic strip to retell the story or finish one of these comics <a href="#">Cat</a>, <a href="#">Fish</a></li> </ul>	<p><b>After reading/listening:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Pick your favorite poem practice reading it aloud and/or act out</li> <li>● Create your own poem             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ If you need ideas for style, Go to your launchpad, open BPS WorldBook, click on Activity Corner, in the search box type poetry (if needed Worldbook User name-brevard1, password-brevard)</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Share your poem with family, friends and/or teacher.</li> </ul>

## STEAM activities

### Choose one

#### Art-Make Harry before he became the dirty dog

- Suggested Materials: Toilet paper roll, paper or use a paper towel or notebook paper, crayons or markers, or any other materials, be creative.
- Design your toilet paper roll or other material to look like Harry before he became the dirty dog. (Does not need to look like the picture- use your imagination) If you can, send a picture to your media specialist.



#### Science/Technology

- Read about animals that are pets, use BPS Worldbook app, 'Kids'. After reading, explain which animal you believe will make the best pet for your family. Create a list of items this pet will need.

#### Engineering

- Create your pet a collar and/or tag. Design your perfect pet house

#### Math

- Take a poll, create a list of 5-7 animals you think make great pets. Now ask friends and family which animal they think makes the best pet.
- Place a tally mark for each animal that gets a vote. Create a graph using the information. Which pet received the most votes? Which received the least? What is the difference between the two?

- Write your poem on your driveway or sidewalk (chalk), or on a poster to share on your mailbox to brighten someone's day.
