Educational Location Option for 2020-2021 (ELO)

For those families who attend Holland Elementary School with the **Educational Location Option** (formerly Out-of-Area), the window for completing ELO applications is **May 1 through June 5** this year. ELOs must be renewed each year. When the window opens, you can apply at: <https://brevardflc.scribborder.com/family>.

Please see below for the upcoming timeline for ELO Applications:

Elementary Schools (Grades K-6)

Excluding Freedom 7, South Lake, R.L. Stevenson, and West Melbourne Elementary

May 1 – June 5	New and Renewal Applications for Elementary Schools
June 12	Lottery for Elementary Schools
June 12 – 19	Notification via Family Dashboard of Seat Offering or Waitlist Status
July 2	Deadline for New Applicants to Accept or Decline Offered Seat via Family Dashboard
June 22 – July 17	Waitlist Applications open for Elementary Schools
July 28	Last day for Schools to Offer Seats from Waitlist (based on space availability)

*Appeal date July 8, 2020

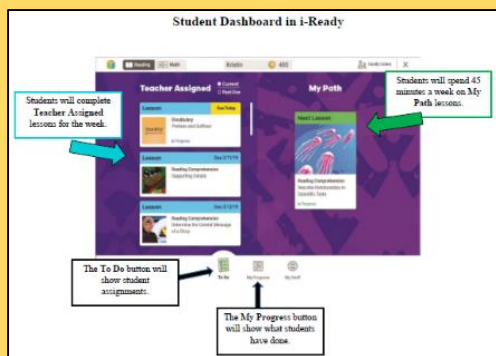

i-Ready Tips for Parents from Mrs. Aloise

- Every week, students and parents should go to the student's Launchpad and sign into FOCUS. Click on the ICP (Instructional Continuity Plan), and that will tell you what the lessons are for the week.
- Your child will then need to go back to his/her Launchpad to access the lessons on the content-area apps.
- Reading lessons consist of completing teacher-assigned i-Ready lesson(s), completing i-Ready minutes on My Path, and independent reading.
- Math lessons consist of completing teacher-assigned i-Ready lessons, and completing i-Ready minutes on My Path.
- When completing i-Ready minutes, if the student is in the middle of the lesson when his/her minutes are up, please do not stop until the lesson is completed. A good rule of thumb is to complete approximately *three* My Path lessons to meet the suggested grade-level minutes.
