

Florida Standards Assessments (FSA)

On **Tuesday, April 5**th and **Wednesday, April 6**th, 3rd Graders will take the READING portion of the FSA, and 4th – 6th Graders will take the WRITING potion on **Thursday, April 7**th. Please take a moment to ask your child about the outstanding reading and writing concepts that they have been learning and how excited they are to "show off" their learning on this assessment!

We ask that students get a good night's rest, eat a healthy breakfast, and be prepared for testing with glasses, sweaters (if needed), etc., on these days.

If your child is not feeling well on the day of testing, he/she can participate in a make-up session.
