On **Tuesday, April 5th** and **Wednesday, April 6th**, 3rd Graders will take the **READING** portion of the FSA, and 4th – 6th Graders will take the **WRITING** portion on **Thursday, April 7th**. Please take a moment to ask your child about the outstanding reading and writing concepts that they have been learning and how excited they are to “show off” their learning on this assessment!

We ask that students get a good night’s rest, eat a healthy breakfast, and be prepared for testing with glasses, sweaters (if needed), etc., on these days.

If your child is not feeling well on the day of testing, he/she can participate in a make-up session.

Some examples of great treats are:

- Soap, shampoo, body wash, face wash.
- Toothpaste, toothbrush, and floss
- Deodorant (travel size/non-aerosol)
- Lip balm
- Foot powder
- Baby wipes
- Sunscreen
- Hand sanitizer
- Vicks VapoRub
- Hand Warmers
- Sewing kits
- Lens cleaning cloths, decks of cards, sunflower seeds, protein bars, and water flavoring packets
