

Recently, this coding team competed in the BPS Innovation Games held at Satellite High School. This was an all-day event in which elementary teams, representing 20+ different schools, shared their programs that were based on an creating an original, informative, and compelling game or web story that features a world-changing topic that they were passionate about such as recycling, animal conservation, anti-bullying, etc. Representatives from each team shared their coding program and gave an oral presentation on Satellite's stage to the audience of about 250 people.
