

PERT Registration Directions

Please make sure you have applied to EFSC first before registering for the PERT at EFSC.

When you apply to EFSC, you will get your acceptance email 2-3 weeks after you have submitted your application, which will contain your EFSC student ID number (B-number). You will need your EFSC ID number in order to register for the PERT.

To register to take the PERT at Eastern Florida State College's campus, use RegisterBlast, EFSC's on-campus testing scheduler.

Students will first receive an email confirmation that they have submitted a request for an access code to take the PERT test. Within 3 days, they will receive another email with the access code, so they can return to the RegisterBlast site to make the actual appointment. Students' should sit for the Reading, Writing, and Math sections. If they are taking a retake, they should just sit for the section(s) they didn't pass.
